

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SIGNATURE OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR ON THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY AND CITY HEALTH OFFICIALS AND WASHTENAW COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT ON THE SYSTEM FOR OPIOID OVERDOSE SURVEILLANCE (S.O.S) WASHTENAW COUNTY PILOT PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$106,284 FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2019 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2019; AMENDING THE BUDGET; AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN DELEGATE CONTRACTS; AND APPROVING THE CREATION OF GRANT STATUS POSITIONS.

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County Health Department has been actively involved in opioid overdose surveillance efforts and actively disseminates data to community stakeholders to help inform response efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Health Department, has been awarded a grant by the National Association of County and City Health Officials to partner with the University of Michigan Injury Prevention Center and HIDTA to pilot the System for Opioid Surveillance (S.O.S) in Washtenaw County; and

WHEREAS, this project promises to improve the identification of near real-time opioid overdose hot spots; and

WHEREAS, the project includes a unique collaboration of public health, EMS, public safety and community organizations; and

WHEREAS, the participation of Washtenaw County Health Department will improve the identification and development of rapid response for opioid overdose hot spot areas in Washtenaw County; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by Corporation Counsel, the Finance Department, Human Resources, the County Administrator's Office, and the Ways and Means Committee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby authorize the Contract with the National Association of County City Health Officials in the amount of \$106,284 for the period of January 1, 2019 through September 30, 2019 as on file with the County Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners takes the following actions contingent upon the receipt of the grant award in conformity with the grant application:

1. Authorizing the Administrator to sign the Contract
2. Amending the budget, as attached hereto and made a part hereof
3. Authorizing the Administrator to sign delegate contracts in conformity with the application/award upon review of Corporation Counsel, to be filed with the County Clerk.
