

A PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING NANCY C. HEDBERG FOR HER YEARS OF  
SERVICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF SCIO TOWNSHIP

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, Nancy C. Hedberg has served the residents of Scio Township for 32 years in many capacities, including as Scio Township Clerk since 2008, and

WHEREAS, Clerk Hedberg has demonstrated outstanding leadership in her community and among her fellow city and township Clerks and enjoys an earned reputation for efficiency, creative problem-solving, and organization; and

WHEREAS, Clerk Hedberg has served as President of the Washtenaw County Municipal and Township Clerks Association since 2013 where she has provided mentorship and support to her peers; and

WHEREAS, Clerk Hedberg contributes her time and knowledge as a member of the Forms Committee convened by the Michigan Bureau of Elections, as Secretary of the Loch Alpine Sanitary Authority, as a current member of the Michigan Association of Municipal Clerks, the Washtenaw Area Transportation Study Policy Committee, League of Women Voters, Washtenaw 100, Weavers Guild of Boston, Michigan League of Handweavers, and Ann Arbor Fiber Arts Guild; and

WHEREAS, Clerk Hedberg served as a member of the Scio Township Planning Commission from 1987 to 2004 and on the Board of Review from 1998 to 2008; and

WHEREAS, Clerk Hedberg has been a member and leader within the Council of Landscape Architectural Registration Boards, Jackson Road Business Association, Wild Ones (a natural landscaping organization), Washtenaw Literacy Council, Michigan Society of Planning Officials, American Society of Landscape Architects, and has served as a panelist with the Ann Arbor Chamber of Commerce and Visiting Lecturer at a University of Michigan graduate Planting Design Class; and

WHEREAS, during her service as Township Clerk, Ms. Hedberg has streamlined the election processes in Scio Township, becoming an early adopter of electronic poll books and developing organizational improvements including detailed, color coded checklists to help poll workers and staff process voters and election returns efficiently; and

WHEREAS, Clerk Hedberg worked to consolidate and redraw precinct lines after the 2010 Census redistricting to reduce the number of ballots styles used by voters in the township from 23 to 10, a change that increased efficiency for voters and resulted in cost savings for the township; and

WHEREAS, Clerk Hedberg has received the distinction of being nominated as the 2019 Michigan Association of Municipal Clerks Township Clerk of the Year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby honors and expresses its most sincere gratitude to Nancy C. Hedberg for her

service to the citizens of Scio Township, the citizens of Washtenaw County, and to her fellow city and township Clerks.
