

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS RULES AND REGULATIONS TO SET THE LENGTH OF CITIZEN PARTICIPATION AT ONLY THE JUNE 6, 2019 WORKING SESSION TO THREE MINUTES

WHEREAS, every year at the organizational meeting in January, the Board of Commissioners approves its Rules and Regulations for the upcoming year; and

WHEREAS, at the January 9, 2019 organizational meeting, the Board of Commissioners approved the 2019 Rules and Regulations through Resolution 19-003, including the procedures by which Working Sessions of the Board of Commissioners would be administered; and

WHEREAS, these rules stipulate that the length of comments from citizens given during the citizen participation section of the meeting be limited to five minutes per speaker; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has instructed the County Administrator to organize a meeting with the other parties intervening in the state lawsuit concerning the Gelman Plume (Resolution 19-099), and to move this meeting to a space which would be able to accommodate both the meeting participants and the members of the public who would attend such a meeting (Resolution 19-100); and

WHEREAS, this meeting has been scheduled for the June 6th, 2019 Working Session of the Board of Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners amends the 2019 Rules and Regulations to set the length of citizen participation to three (3) minutes for only the June 6, 2019 Working Session.
