

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE WASHTENAW
COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2014, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners passed a resolution establishing the Washtenaw County Board of Health (14-0111); and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2015, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners passed a resolution approving the by-laws of the Washtenaw County Board of Health (15-0060); and

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Health is responsible for developing and overseeing a strategic plan for the Department of Health; recommending an annual budget to the County Administrator; and, in cooperation with the County Administrator, regularly evaluating the performance of the Washtenaw County Public Health Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Health is comprised of 10 members, 9 voting members and 1 Washtenaw County Commissioner as an ex officio member, representing a diversity of the community and providing a wide range of expertise on local public health issues, with the following sector representation to be preferred: Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners, health service delivery, environmental health and conservation, land use planning, food service and nutrition, academia, k-12 education, philanthropy, social service delivery, legal services, and consumers of public health services; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby appoints the following member to the Board of Health for the remainder of a three-year term expiring December 31, 2021:
