

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PACKAGE OF BILLS KNOWN AS THE CIVIL RIGHTS EXPANSION PACKAGE, AS IS BEING CONSIDERED BY THE MICHIGAN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County has had a long history of actions and statement which recognize the civil rights of all residents; and

WHEREAS, this past June, the “Civil Rights Expansion Package” was introduced in the Michigan House of representatives, and that the bills and resolutions included in this package are designed to extend Michigan’s civil rights protections to all Michigan residents, regardless of an individual’s place of birth; and

WHEREAS, the “Civil Rights Expansion Package” is composed of Michigan House Bills 4724, 4725, 4726, 4727, 4797, 4798, 4799 and House Resolution 126; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby expresses its strong support for the Civil Rights Expansion Package being considered in the Michigan House of Representatives.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners hereby directs the County Administrator to share this resolution with representatives in Lansing expressing their support of the package of bills known as the “Civil Rights Expansion Package.”
