



# Community Input Sessions: Reporting Results

**Background** - Washtenaw County Office of Community and Economic Development and City of Ypsilanti hosted a series of meetings with residents who live in the neighborhood located south of W. Michigan Avenue in Ypsilanti. The meetings were about identifying and prioritizing investments in this community.



**The Results** - Individuals in attendance were given 5 stickers to vote on the list of proposed projects, generated by members of the community. They could use multiple endorsements for one item they felt strongly about or could spread them out across 5 different projects.

**Top Priority**

New Playground Equipment for Parkridge Park

**Secondary Priorities**

- Funding home improvements for owner-occupied residents
- Repairing the water fountains around Parkridge Park
- Repaving and repairing the basketball courts at Parkridge Park

**Next Steps** - The City and County committed to implementing these projects based on funding availability over the next few years.

**Fall 2019** | The City and County will meet to discuss project funding, budget, and timelines.

**Fall 2019/Winter 2020** | County obtains HUD Clearance.

**Spring 2020** | Project will be open to bids from contractors, prioritizing contractors living in Ypsilanti or Washtenaw County when possible. Contracts for project(s) will be executed.

**Summer 2020** | Project(s) Begin.
