Annual Pass Terms and Conditions • Annual Pass is valid for current season only

- Independence Lake County Park is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged season passes. Lost/stolen passes can be replaced for a fee of \$5 per replacement. They will not be refunded.
- Independence Lake County Park is not responsible for if you forget to bring your passes when visiting. If you forget your passes you will have to pay a \$3 per family service charge for us to manually input your visit. They will not be refunded.
- Season Pass is a final sale (no refunds) and non-transferable.
- The Season Pass may only be used by the individuals the pass was purchased for and identified in the Independence Lake County Park system.
- The Season Pass may only be used once per day for one admission to the Blue Heron Bay Spray Park. If leaving and coming back a hand stamp will be given.
- The Season Pass does NOT allow admission into Rolling Hills County Park waterpark.
- Must show valid state ID to verify identity when redeeming Season Pass for admission.
- The season pass is redeemed for admission at the admissions booth.
- Vehicle admission is sold separately at the gatehouse. Annual Vehicle passes available for purchase.
- Children ages 11 and younger must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Season Pass does not guarantee admission. Spray Park is subject to capacity.

- Maximum capacity policy: The maximum number of people allowed in Blue Heron Bay at one time is 750 people. Although we have not reached maximum capacity, if it does occur then the one person allowed in Blue Heron Bay for one person out of Blue Heron Bay procedure will take place. Annual pass holders will also have to abide by this procedure by waiting in line to get into Blue Heron Bay if maximum capacity is reached. This also applies if maximum capacity of parking spaces is reached in the general park. Annual pass holders will have to wait in the car line to get in to the park, abiding by the one car in for one car out procedure if maximum car capacity is reached.
- No refunds or rain checks due to early closing, inclement weather, mechanical failure, contamination related incidents or low attendance.
 - Weather policy: Annual pass holders will have to abide by the weather policies set for Blue Heron Bay. If thunder is heard or lightning is seen then the spray pad is cleared and nobody else is allowed to enter Blue Heron Bay for 30 minutes. Every time thunder is heard or lightning is seen the 30 minute clock resets. If there is a tornado warning or a tornado has been seen Blue Heron Bay will immediately close. If the air temperature is below seventy degrees at 9:30am then Blue Heron Bay may close for the day. Sign up for alerts on our website; Washtenaw.org.
- Season Pass users are subject to all Blue Heron Bay, Independence Lake County Park and Washtenaw County Parks and Recreation Commission rules and regulations.
