

# CAN YOU BE EVICTED DURING THE COVID-19 CRISIS?

## NO!

Evictions are banned statewide **until at least July 15th**. This does not include individuals who pose a serious risk to a person or property.



## Does that mean you don't owe rent right now?

No - you are still responsible for any rent and fees that become due during the COVID-19 crisis.

## What if you can't afford rent due to COVID-19?

If you need assistance paying rent, you can reach out to a Barrier Busters agency to see if you can receive financial assistance at [Washtenaw.org/2818](http://Washtenaw.org/2818)



## Is the July 15th deadline the same for everyone?

If you have a housing voucher, live in subsidized housing, or if your landlord has a federally backed mortgage or accepts housing vouchers, new evictions can not move forward until July 25th, at which point 30 days notice is required.
