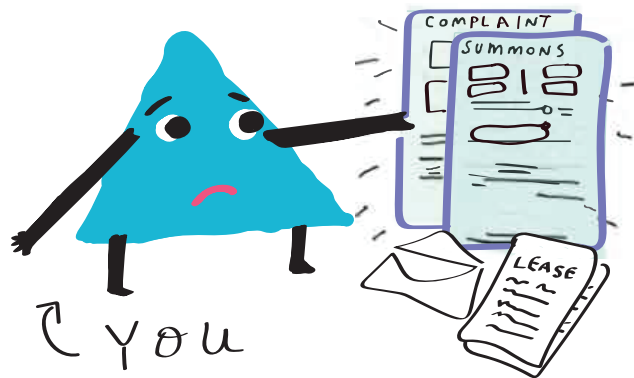

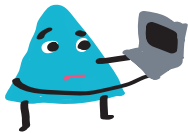


If you don't act right now, you may be evicted.

Talk to a lawyer or look at reliable online resources to understand your options & how to protect yourself.



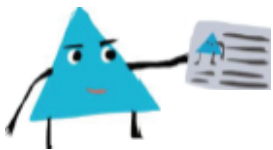

3 CONTACT THE COURT ABOUT YOUR HEARING

You must be at court, either by phone or video, or in person, at the date and time listed on your summons. If you show up, free legal and financial aid may be available to you. IF YOU DO NOT SHOW UP, a judgment will be taken against you. This can lead to eviction, bad credit reports, and inability to get other housing.
