COVID-19 vaccines are safe, effective, and can help protect you and your family!

To request a vaccine from the Health Department:

- 1) Complete our Health Department appointment request form online: <http://bit.ly/wchdvaxsignup> (if you need help with the online form, please call: 734-544-6700 or 211)
- 2) Once you complete this form, you will be "in line" to receive an appointment. When we have an appointment for you, we will call or email you.

If you need assistance at your appointment, please let us know!

**Vaccine supplies are limited everywhere right now.
Please be patient when waiting for an appointment.
It may be months away, depending on supplies.**

- If you are a patient with Michigan Medicine, Saint Joseph Mercy Health System, the VA, or IHA: your doctor may also contact you if they have a vaccine appointment available.
- Local pharmacies may also be able to provide vaccine. Meijer (<https://clinic.meijer.com>) and Rite Aid (<http://bit.ly/3qca7Tg>) are offering limited appointments. Both have online registration and your local Meijer can provide phone assistance.
