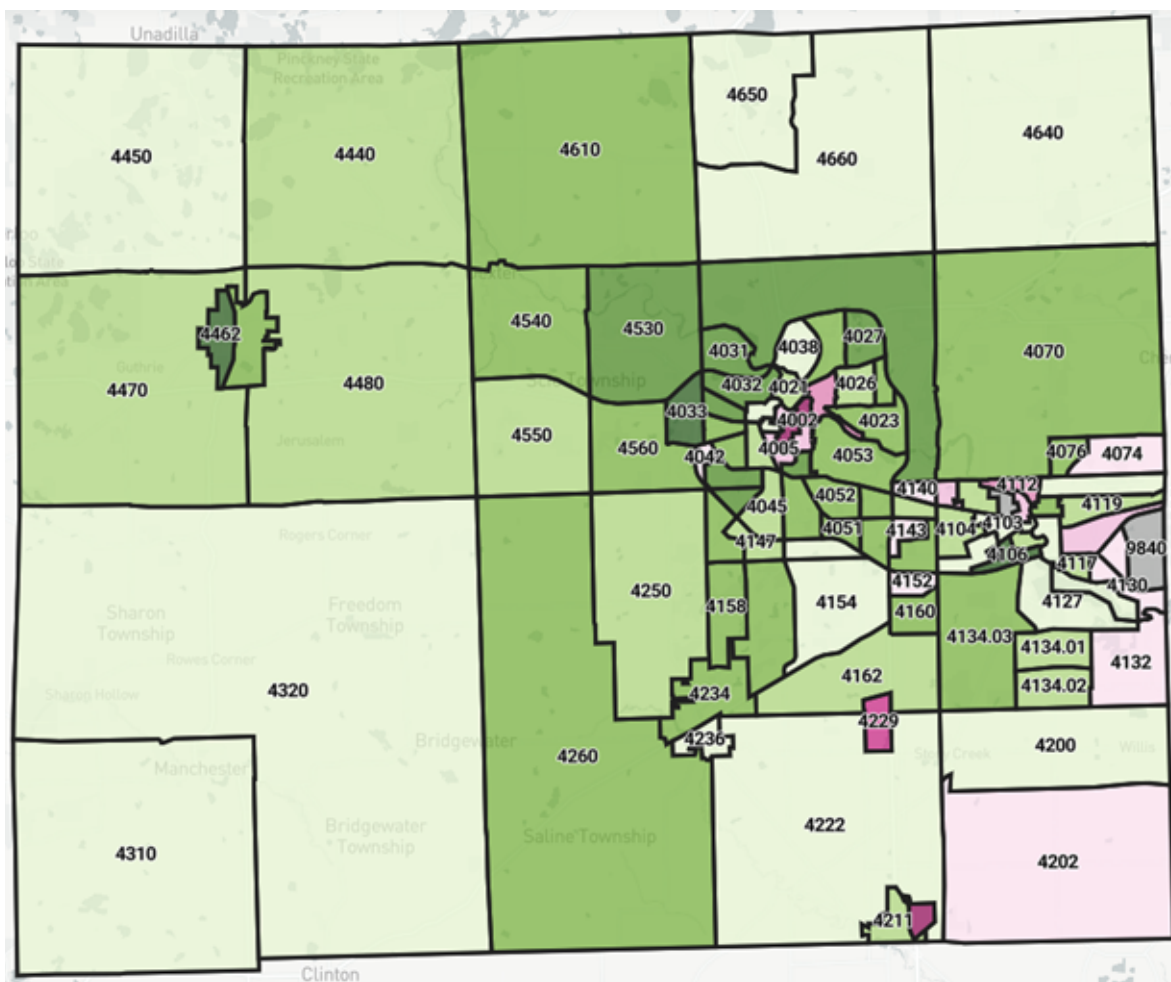


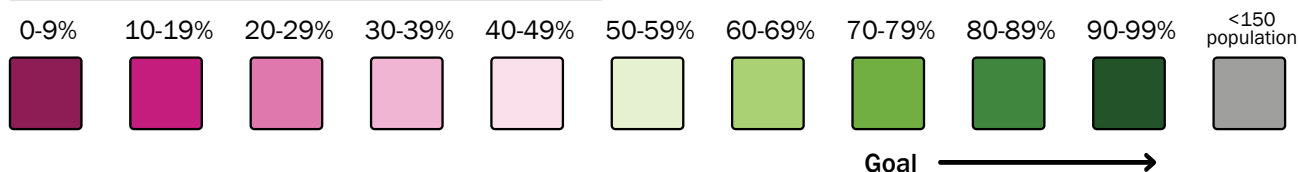
COVID-19 Vaccine Status in Washtenaw County Residents 16+ years by Census Tract

Legend: Received 1 or more dose (% ages 16+)

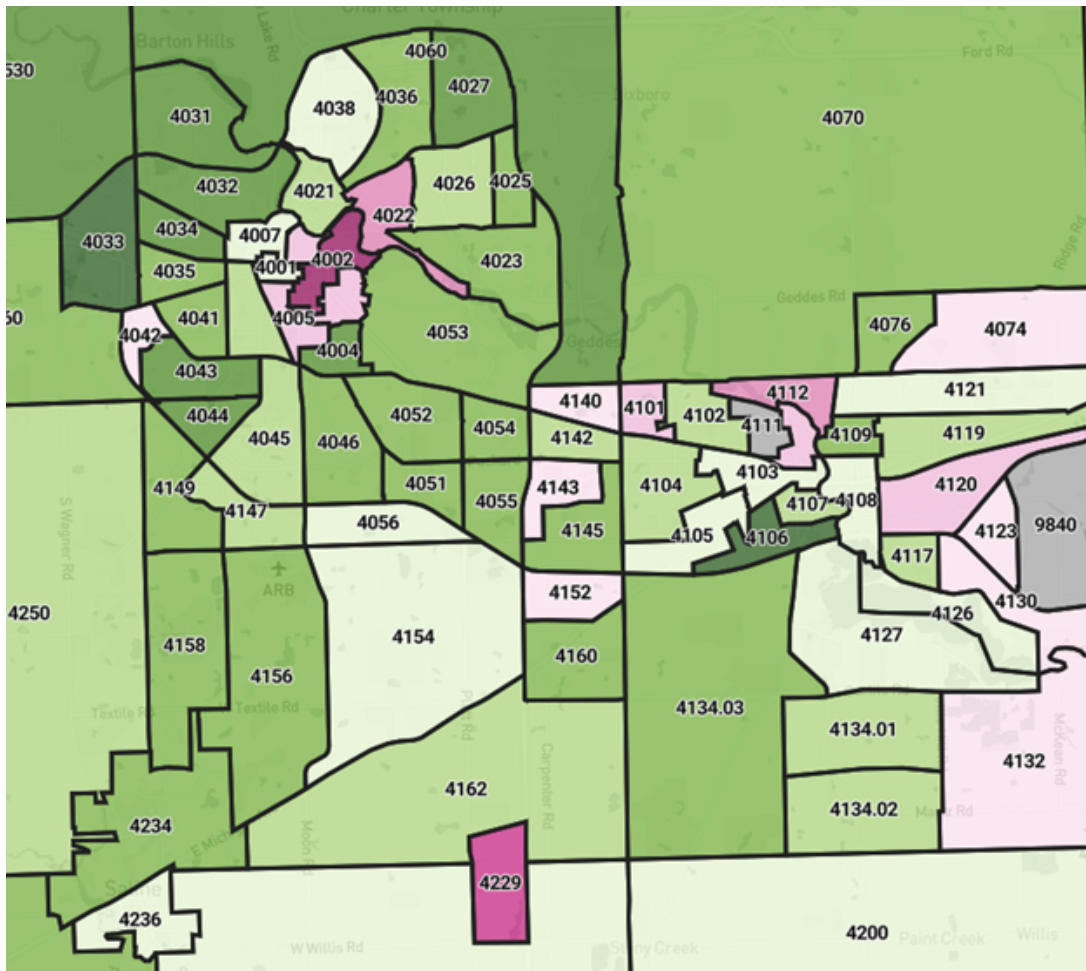

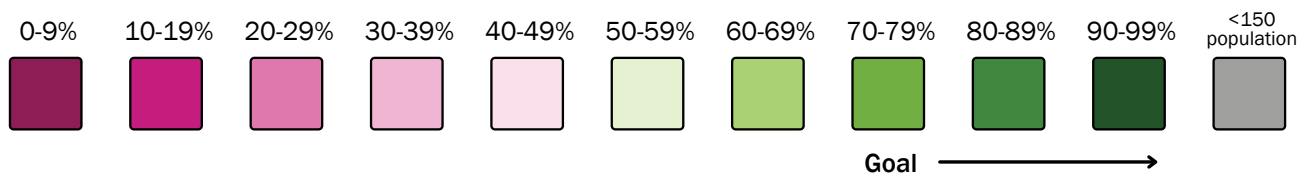

Data Notes

- Data source: Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR)
- Data are preliminary. Vaccination rates are calculated using population numbers (of those 16+) for each tract. Population numbers obtained from the 2018 American Community Survey (ACS).
- Some COVID-19 vaccine doses are not yet in MCIR including individuals who were vaccinated by the VA Medical System and those who went out-of-state for vaccine (e.g. Ohio).
- Two of the tracts with dark pink color (4229 and 4219) have large correctional facilities where vaccine is not accurately reflected in MCIR.
