Team Decision Making meetings (TDM) are convened by DHHS when a separation of child and parent is being considered because a child's safety is seriously threatened by parental action or inaction; OR when a child in care faces a possible move; OR when reunification is being considered.

TDM meetings bring together the family, their support persons, DHHS and other professionals, AND members of the community, in order to make the best possible decision about where a child should live. TDM meetings seek to balance safety with the child's need for family and community connections!

DHHS can't do it alone. We need community members to help us support families and keep their children safe!
