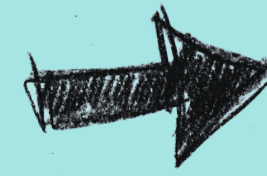
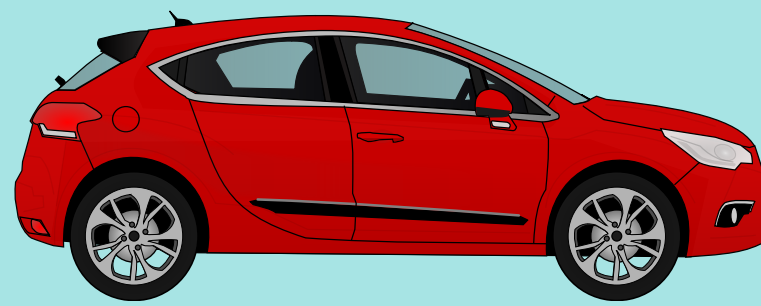
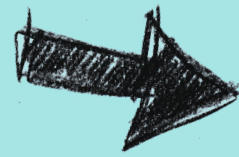
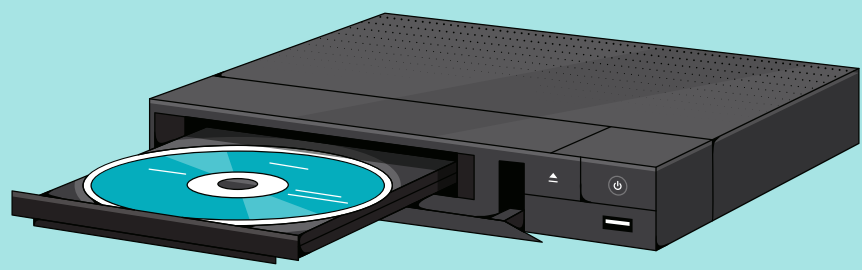


ELECTRONIC WASTE RECYCLING



In-Person Process

Most smaller electronics can be recycled for free at local locations. Businesses such as Staples and Best Buy will take many old electronic items such as DVD players, copiers, stereos, laptops and printers. A full listing is available on the website of each business.



1. Call store or visit store website to verify the items you want to recycle are accepted (varies by location).
2. Bring your items to the store and let an employee know that you are bringing electronics to recycle.
3. The employee will direct you to an area to drop off the items. Or, the employee may take the items for you.
