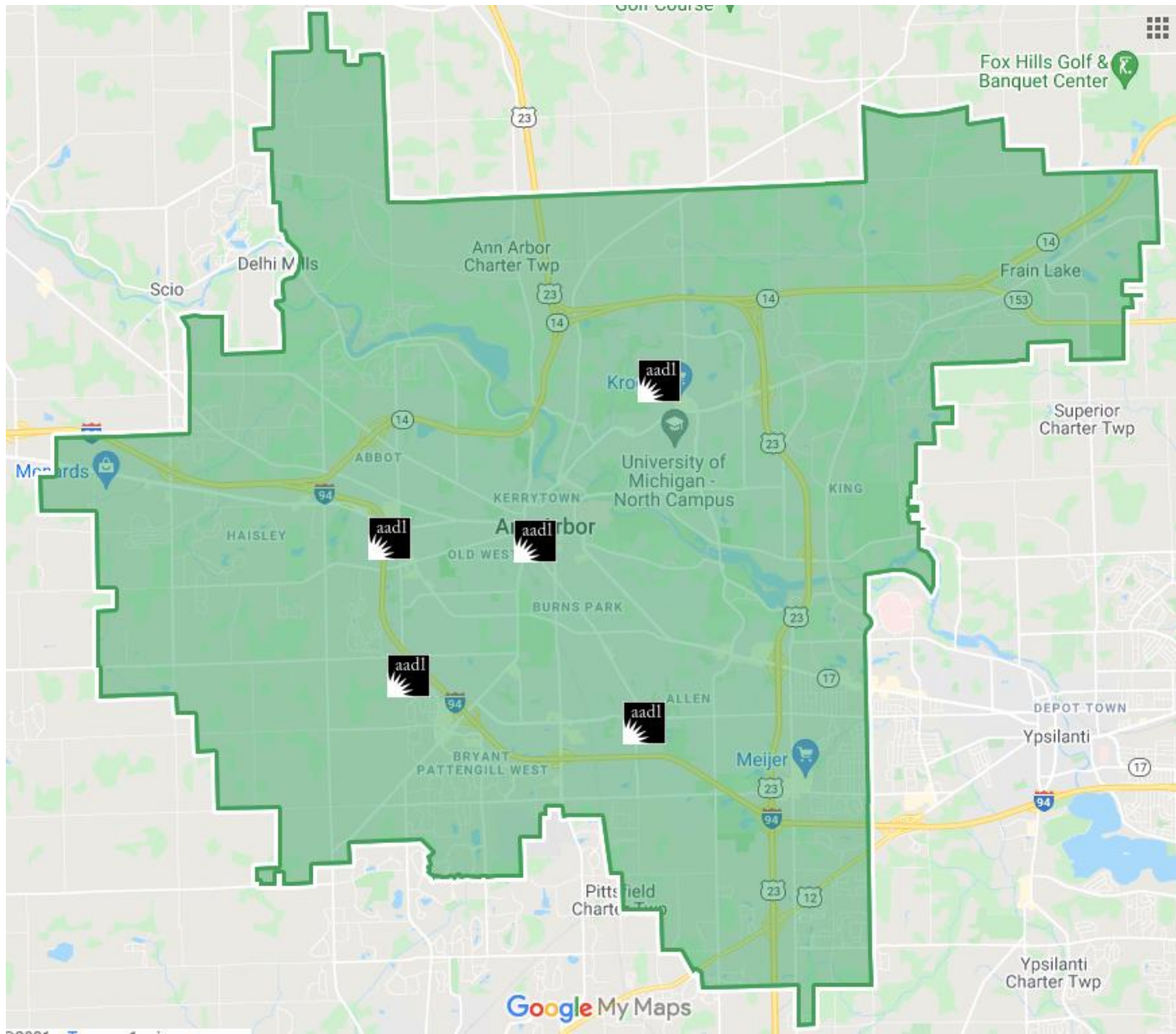

Homebound Service

- Available to any patron residing within the Ann Arbor District Library service boundaries who is temporarily or permanently homebound.
- Library items are mailed to the patron at no charge



Print Service

- AADL will print documents & mail them to patrons
 - e.g. homework, worksheets, documents, applications
- This service is here to help do essential paperwork for schooling, housing, healthcare, benefits, taxes, banking, and similar needs.
- Most orders will be ready for contactless pickup the next weekday in the AADL Lobby of choice. There is no fee for service if under 30 pages.
