A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A 9-DISTRICT REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Apportionment Commission has the statutory authority and responsibility to adopt an apportionment plan every 10 years; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has established a plan with districts of substantially equal population; and

WHEREAS, this plan is made up of single-member districts; and

WHEREAS, these districts are contiguous; and

WHEREAS, these districts are as nearly square in shape as is practicable; and

WHEREAS, no district combined a township (or part of) with any city unless necessary to meet the population standard; and

WHEREAS, no districts divided townships, villages, or cities unless necessary to meet the population standard; and

WHEREAS, no districts divided precincts unless necessary to meet the population standard; and

WHEREAS, these districts were not drawn to effect partisan political advantage;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Apportionment Commission adopts its 2021 reapportionment plan of 9 districts, which fits the requisite criteria as best as possible.
