NOTICE OF EXCEEDING MAINTENANCE LIMIT

The Wildwood Lake Sub Drain is a stormwater system under the jurisdiction of the Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner. Per the Michigan Drain Code, Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, the Office of the Water Resources Commissioner is authorized to spend an annual amount of \$5,000 per mile of drain on maintenance. If that amount is exceeded, there is a statutory requirement to notify the property owners within the drainage district.

The annual maintenance limit on the Wildwood Lake Sub Drain was exceeded by authorized resolution from Northfield Township. The resolution authorized the Office of the Water Resources Commissioner to complete the repair of a collapsed pipe at Timbercrest Lane and Barker Road, as well as pipe cleaning and replacement behind 9025 Timbercrest towards Barker Road.

Pursuant to Section 196(6) of The Michigan Drain Code, Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, please take notice that the expenditure amount on the Wildwood Lake Sub Drain exceeded the amount established under Section 196(4), and an assessment will be levied for the amount expended on the Wildwood Lake Sub Drain.
