NOTICE OF EXCEEDING MAINTENANCE LIMIT

The Streamwood #8 Drain is a stormwater system under the jurisdiction of the Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner. Per the Michigan Drain Code, Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, the Office of the Water Resources Commissioner is authorized to spend an annual amount of \$5,000 per mile of drain on maintenance. If that amount is exceeded, there is a statutory requirement to notify the property owners within the drainage district.

The annual maintenance limit on the Streamwood #8 Drain was exceeded by Emergency Order authorized by Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner. The emergency order was authorized to remove extensive root blockages inside the storm lines, as well as repair/rebuild the structures.

Pursuant to Section 196(6) of The Michigan Drain Code, Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, please take notice that the expenditure amount on the Streamwood #8 Drain exceeded the amount established under Section 196(4), and an assessment will be levied for the amount expended on the Streamwood #8 Drain.
