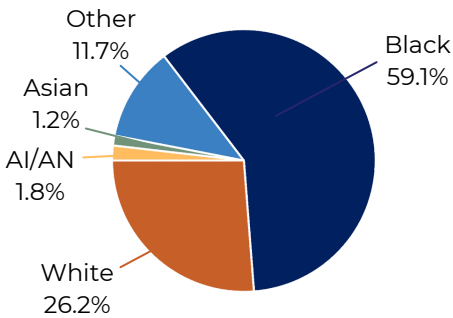


HIGHLIGHTS

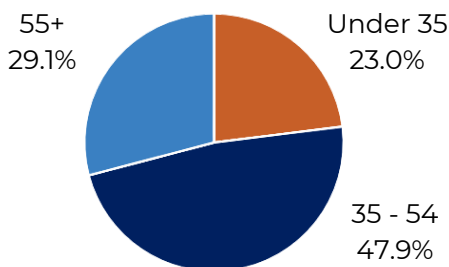
- 2x** increase of nearly 2x as many requests made to support Black households this quarter compared to the 4th quarter of 2020.
- 39%** of total requests in this quarter went toward utility assistance, compared to 55% in the 4th quarter 2020.
- 9%** increase in requests from residents aged 55 and over this quarter compared to the 4th quarter of 2020.

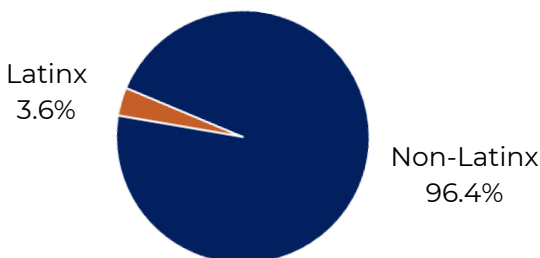

Age

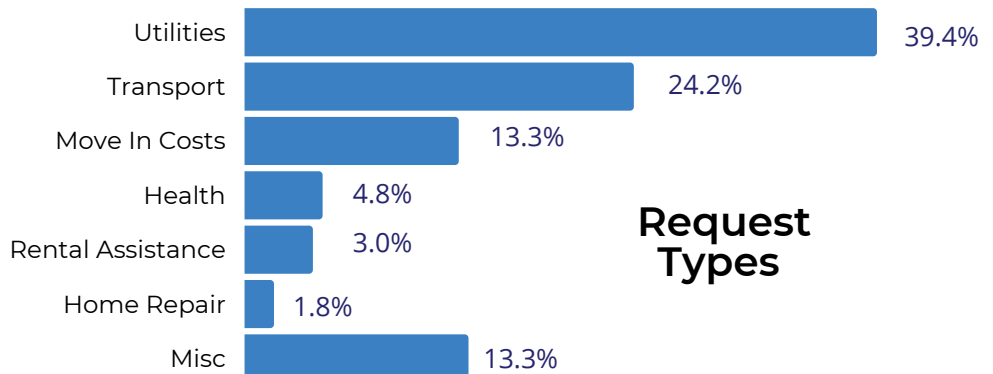
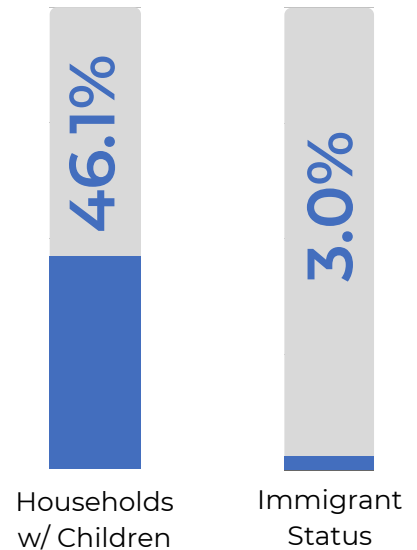


Ethnicity
