City of Ann Arbor Water Utilities Fund	Water utility assistance for City of Ann Arbor Residents	N/A City of Ann Arbor provides account credits
Immigrant Assistance Fund	Funds to be utilized for low to moderate households with at least one immigrant member	\$50.25
Pittsfield Township Emergency Assistance	Pittsfield Township Residents Only	\$606.03
MCA Greatest Need	Housing and Utilities Only	\$984.96
Washtenaw County General Funds	1 assistance per year must be under 50% AMI	\$420.38
