DEXTER TOWNSHIP – 1 PROPOSAL

DEXTER TOWNSHIP FARMLAND AND OPEN SPACE LAND PRESERVATION MILLAGE PROPOSAL TO PERMANENTLY PRESERVE FARMLAND AND OPEN SPACE THROUGHOUT THE TOWNSHIP BY PROVIDING FUNDING FOR THE VOLUNTARY PURCHASE OF CONSERVATION EASEMENTS.

Shall the Township of Dexter authorize a new levy of 0.5 mills (\$.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) to finance the Township of Dexter's Farmland and Open Space Land Preservation program to permanently preserve farmland, open space, wildlife habitat, scenic views, and protect drinking water sources and the water quality of rivers and streams, by funding the voluntary purchase of interests in land throughout the Township, and enable the Township to take advantage of matching funds, for a period of ten years, with the new levy commencing in December, 2022, with the first year revenue estimated to be \$220,810.00?

DEXTER DISTRICT LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL – 1 PROPOSAL

Shall the Dexter District Library, Counties of Washtenaw and Livingston, be authorized to levy annually a renewal of the previously voted increase in the tax limitation, which expires in 2022, in an amount not to exceed .6620 mill (\$0.6620 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property within the Dexter District Library district for a period of six (6) years, 2023 to 2028, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Dexter District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied in the 2023 calendar year is approximately \$1,072,000.
