

JOSLIN LAKE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Joslin Lake Improvement Project (Project), which originated in 2009 and was not renewed after five years, is seeking to initiate a new five-year Project to control the growth and reproduction of non-native aquatic invasive plants, including but not limited to Eurasian Watermilfoil and Starry Stonewort. The Project will also work to control the growth of nuisance native plants, including but not limited to Chara and Variable Pondweed. The Project will focus on maintaining the ecological health and recreational opportunities for Joslin Lake. Additionally, other items may be included which would provide support for maintaining the ecological health and recreational opportunities, that will be subject to approval by the Washtenaw County Board of Public Works (WCBPW).

A Special Assessment District (SAD) consisting of benefiting parcels in Washtenaw County will cover the total estimated cost of the Project. The WCBPW has developed a tentative SAD to cover the total estimated cost of the Project. The proposed maximum annual charges per year are below.

The estimated cost to cover the proposed 5-year SAD is \$284,130.

All parcels within the SAD are proposed to be assessed one or more of the following charges:

Non-waterfront residential properties with lake access	\$190 per year, \$950 over 5 years
Waterfront residential properties	\$515 per year, \$2,575 over 5 years
Department of Natural Resources	\$750 per year, \$3,750 over 5
years	

Exemption: Parcels that are contiguous to an assessed parcel with the same owner will be assessed once at the highest single parcel assessment level.



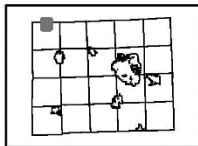
