Funding Source	Requirements	Amount Available
City of Ann Arbor Water Utilities Fund	Water utility assistance for City of Ann Arbor Residents	N/A City of Ann Arbor provides account credits
Ann Arbor General Use Funds	Can be used for utilities or housing by Ann Arbor City residents	\$4153.07
Washtenaw County General Funds	1 assistance per year must be under 50% AMI	\$210,784
