Section 3 Business Concern

Is defined as a business concern that is 51% or more owned by Section 3 Residents

Whose permanent full time employees include persons, at least 30% of whom are currently Section 3 residents or within three years of the date of first employment with the business concern were Section 3 residents;

OR

That provides evidence of a commitment to subcontract in excess of 25% of the dollar award of all subcontracts to be awarded to business concerns that meet the qualifications set forth in paragraphs (1) OR (2) in this definition of "Section 3 business concern".
