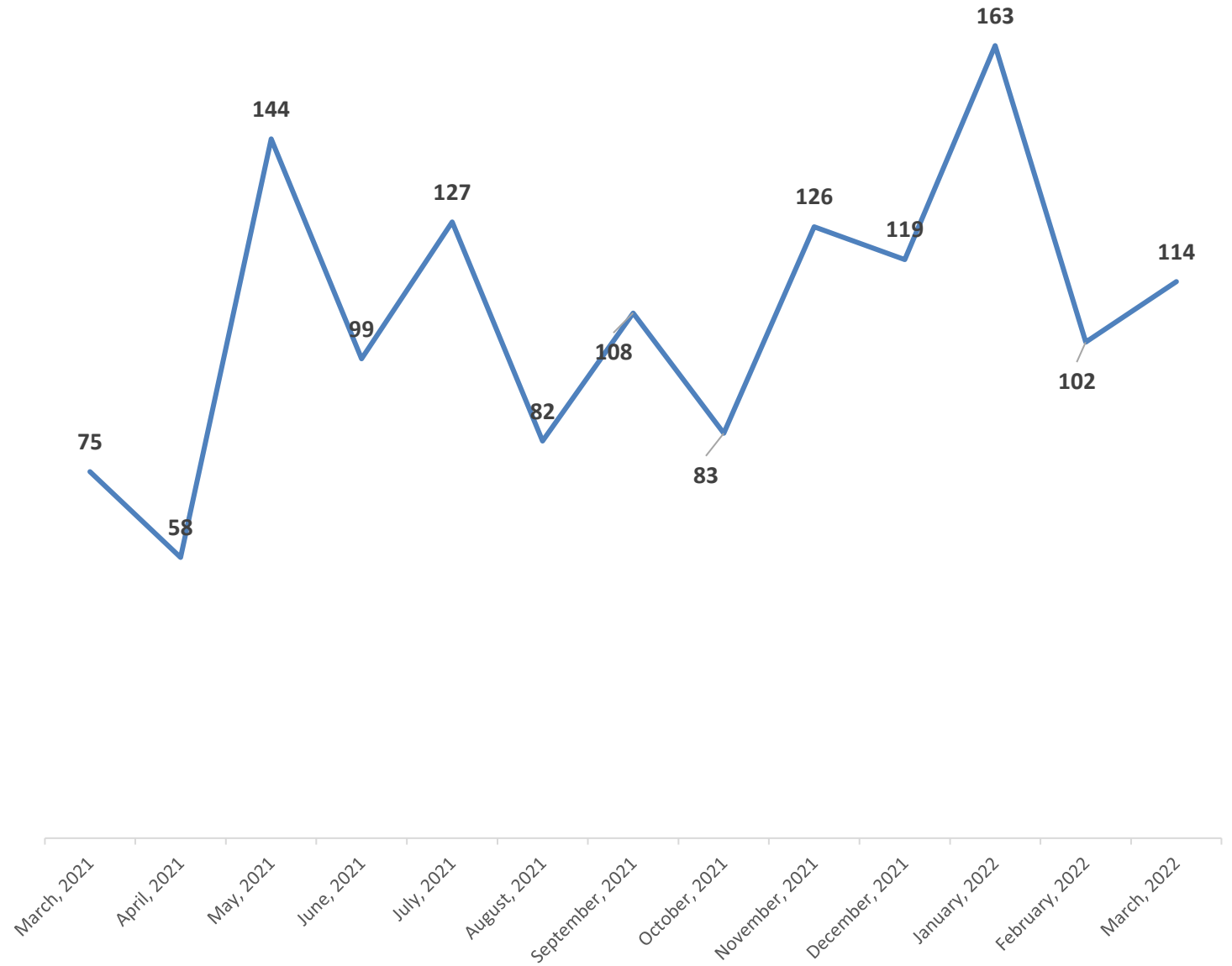


# Veteran By Name List: 3 Month Lookback



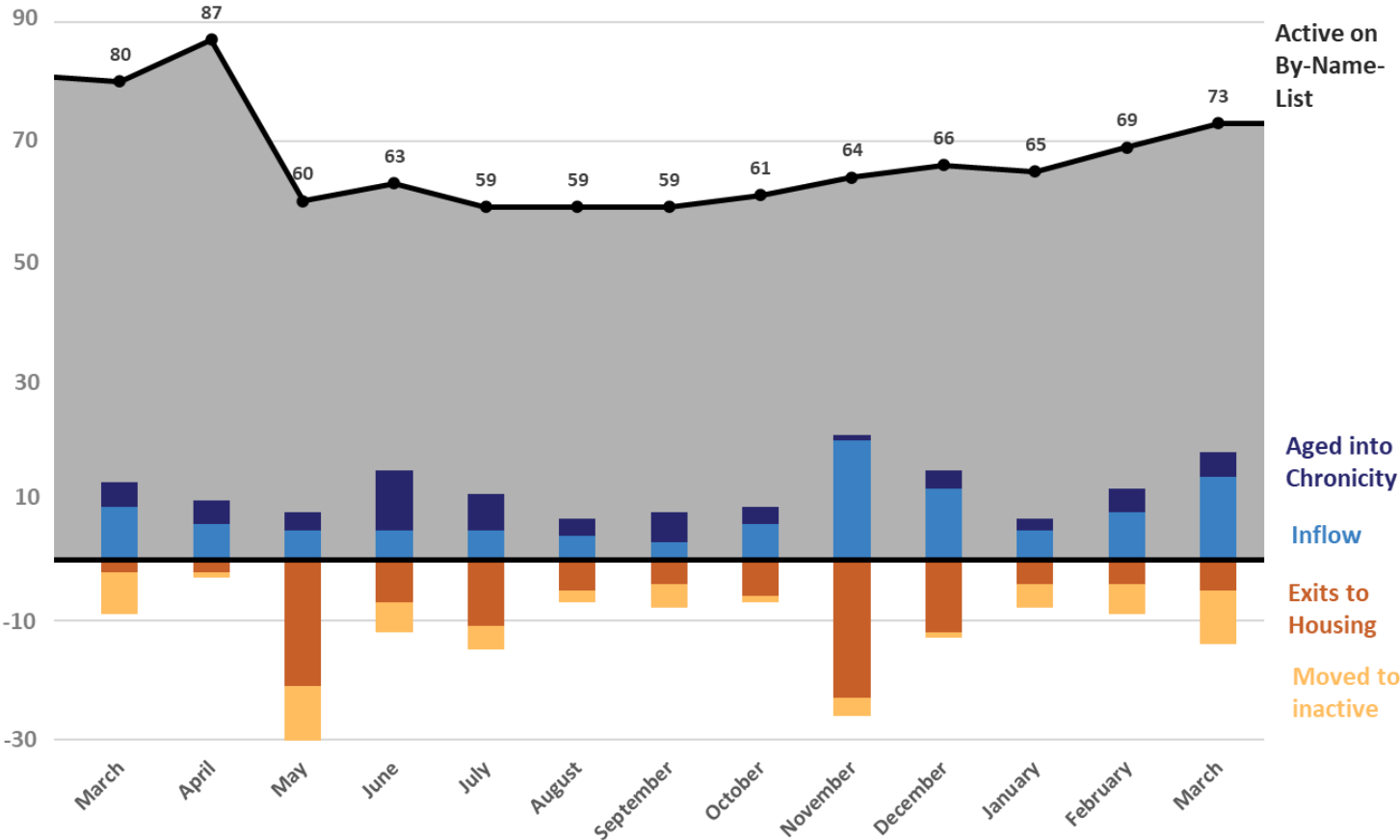

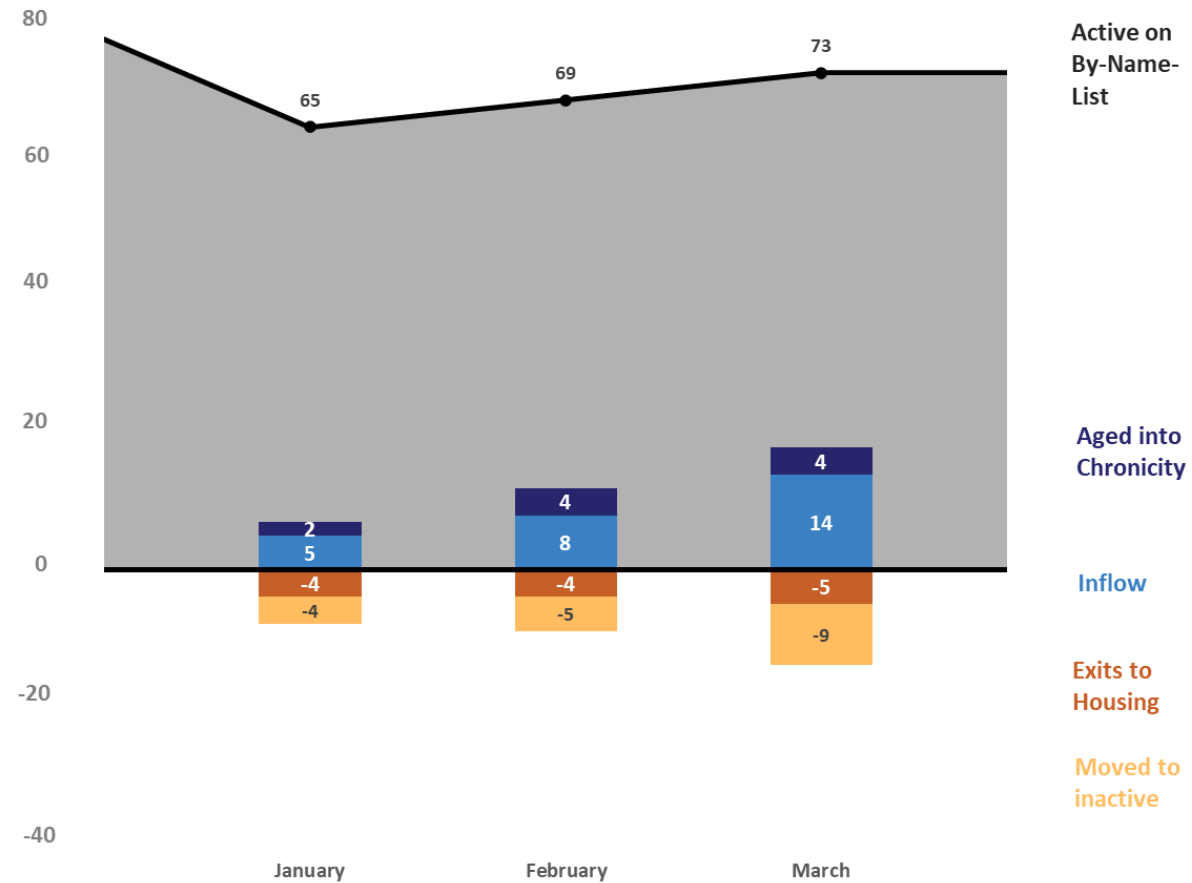

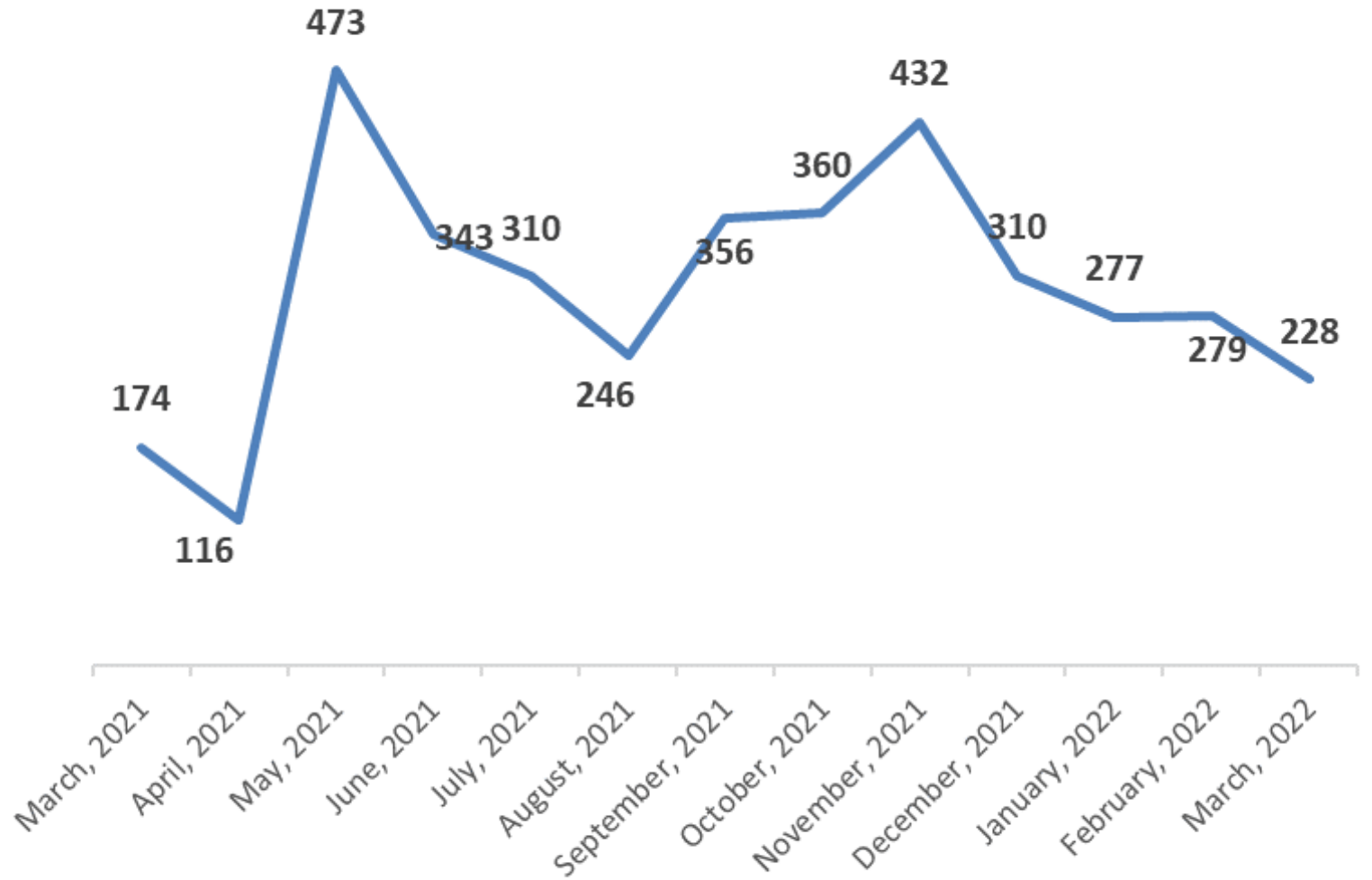


# Chronic By Name List: 3 Month Lookback

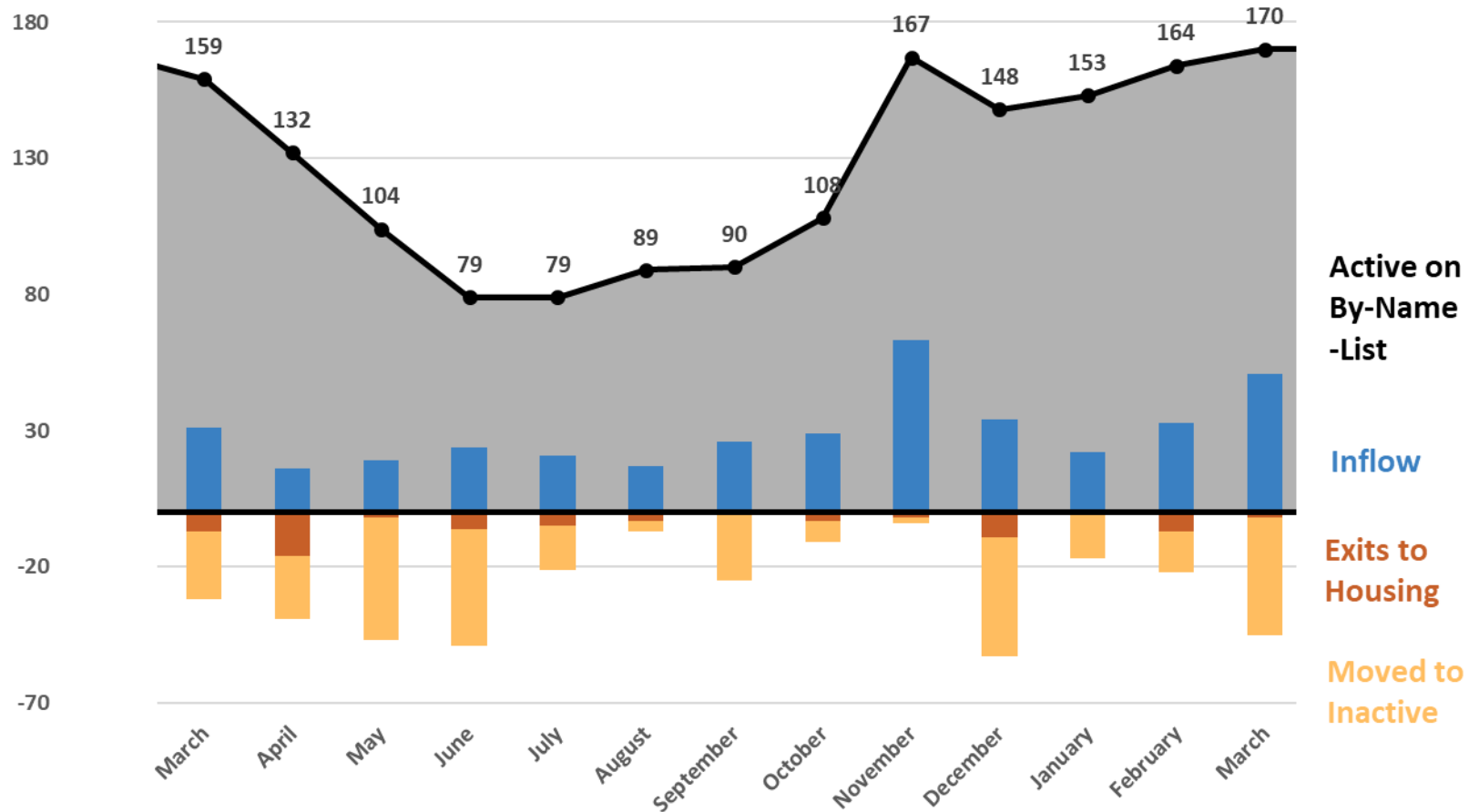

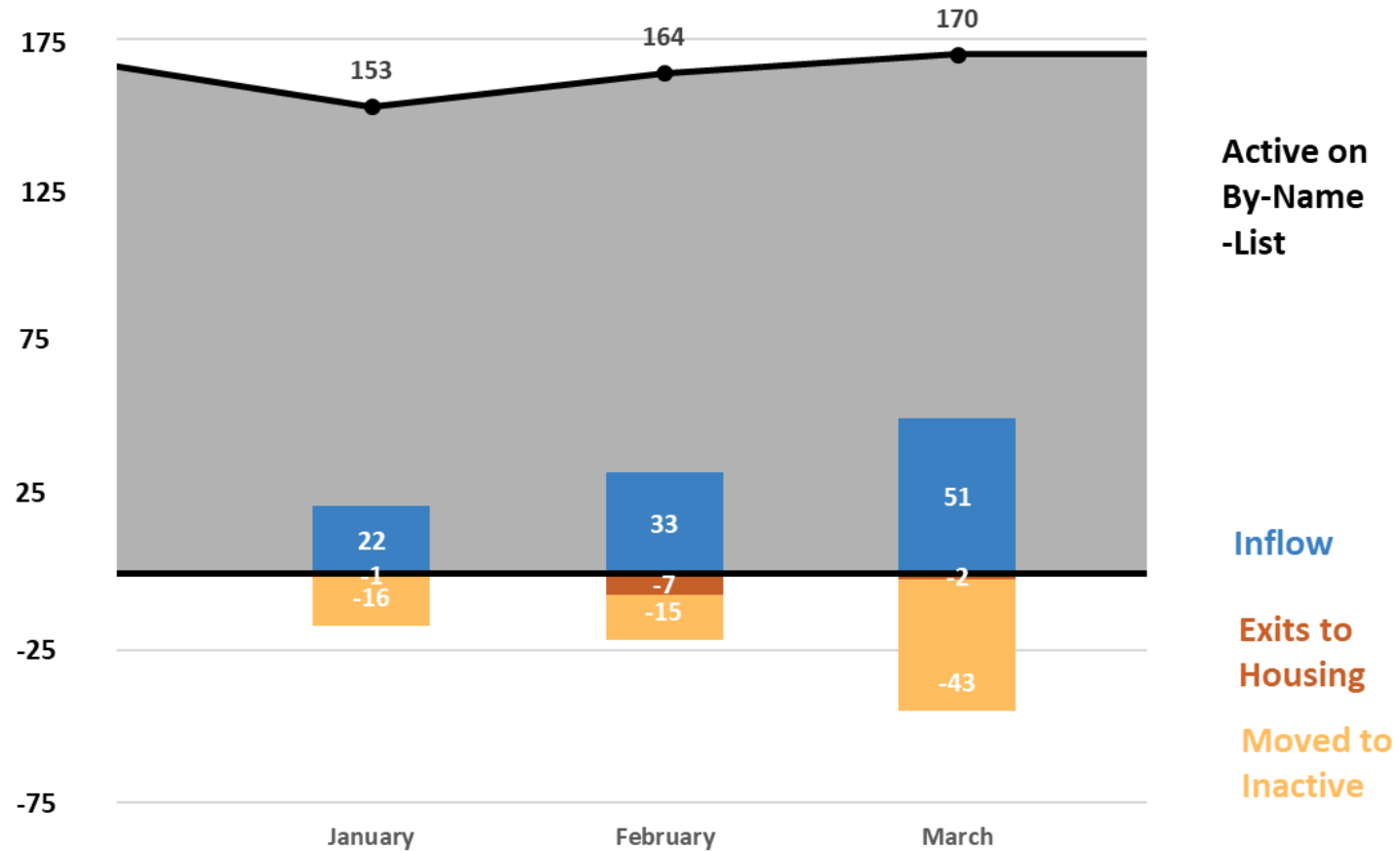
Average Length of Time to Housing, in Days

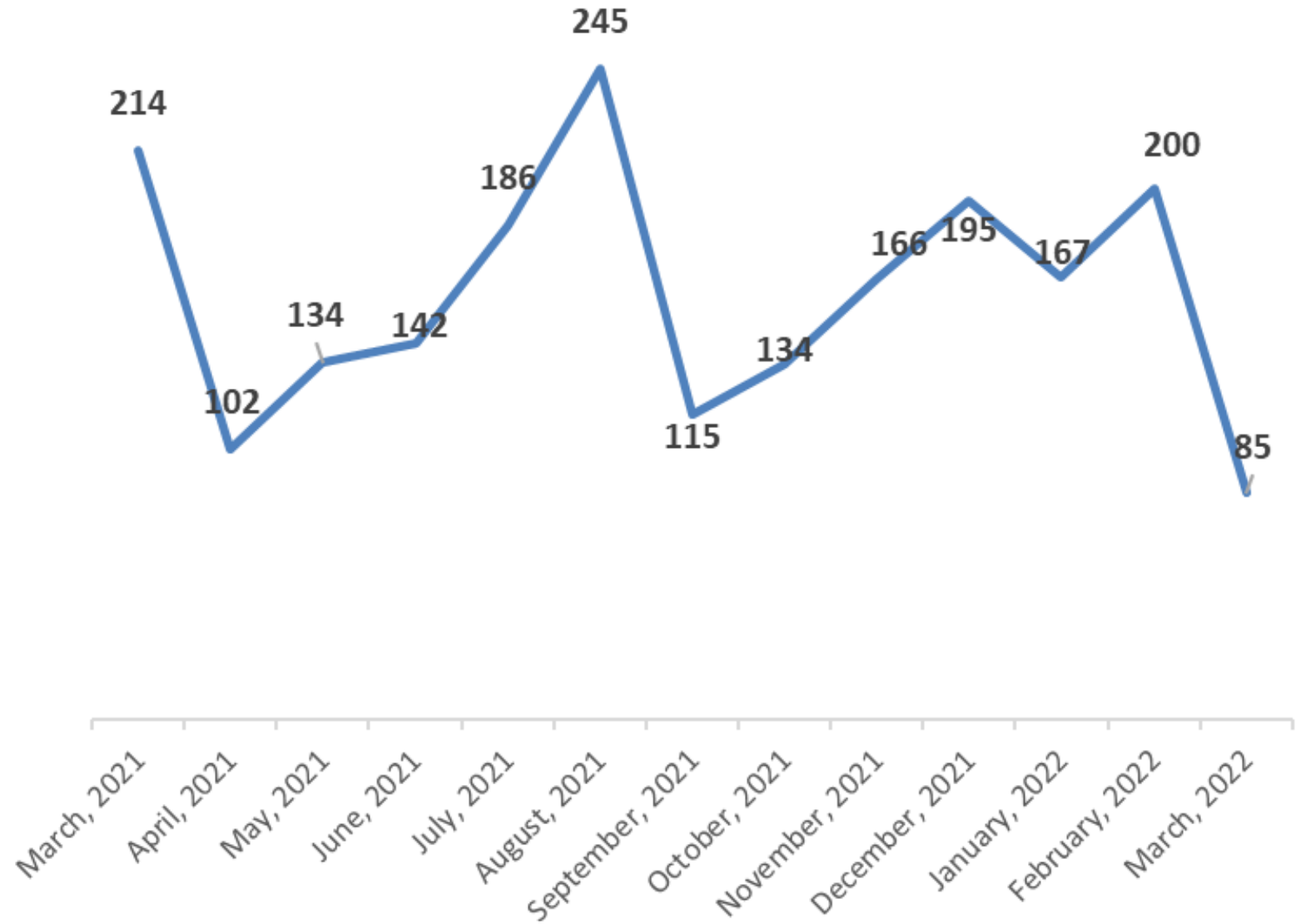


# Non-Chronic By Name List: 3 Month Lookback

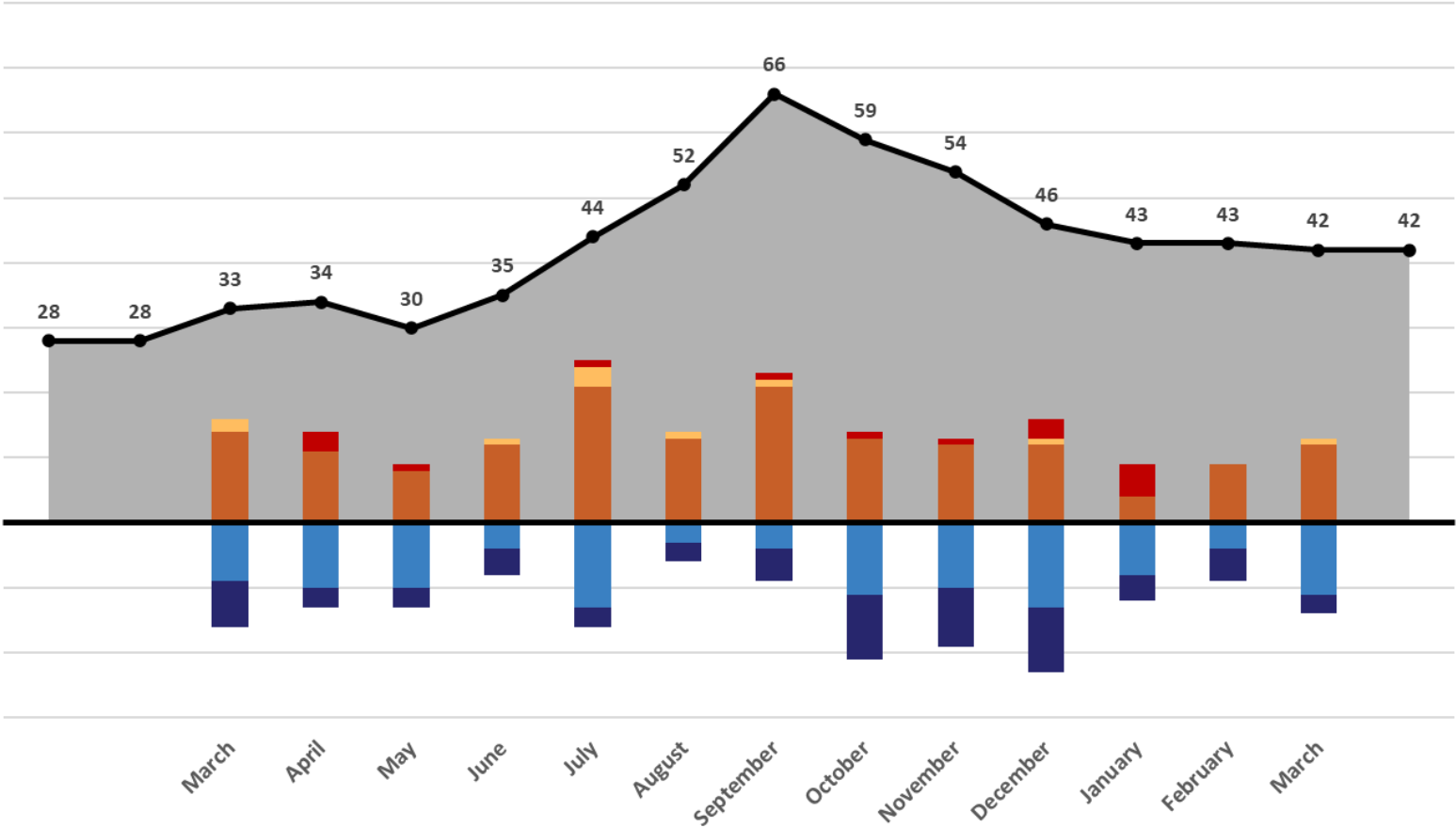

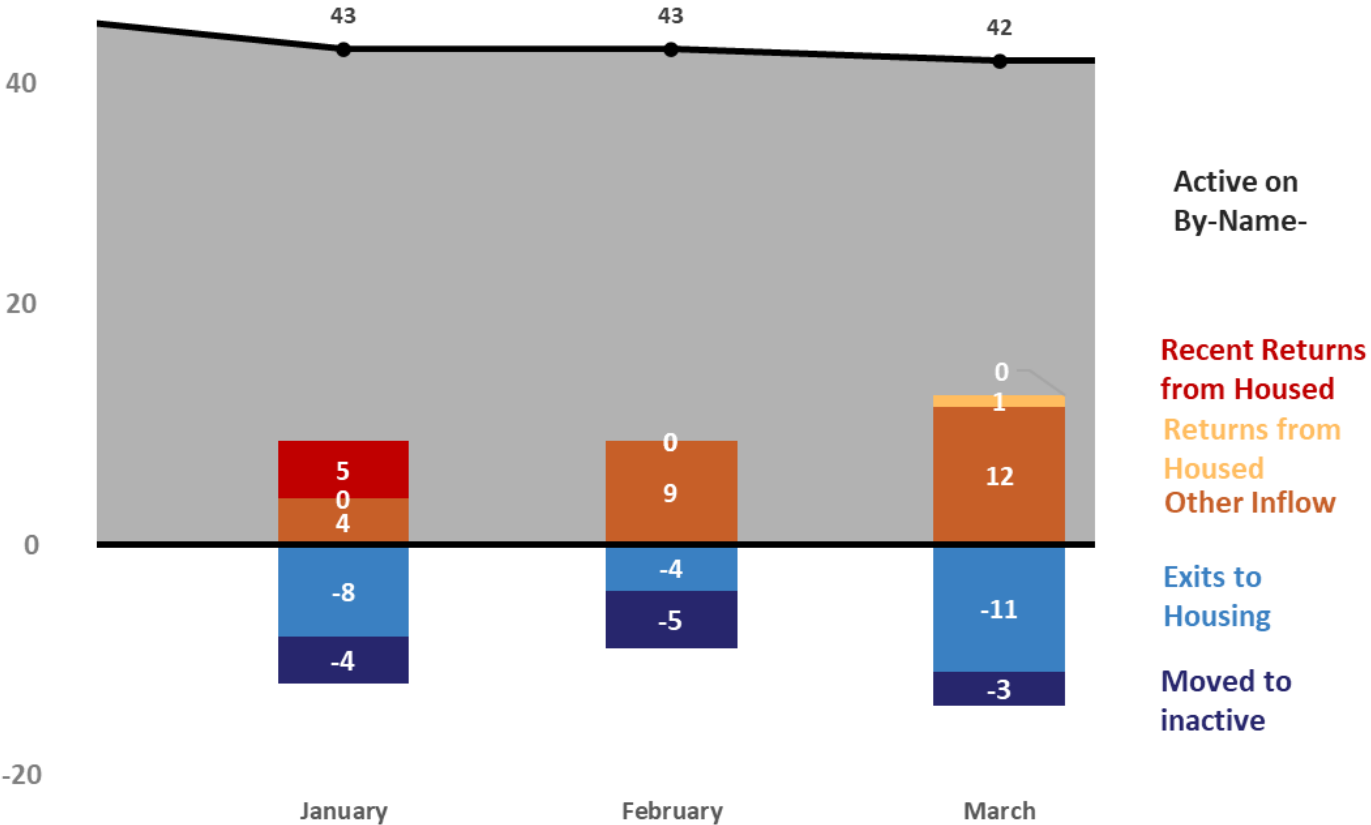

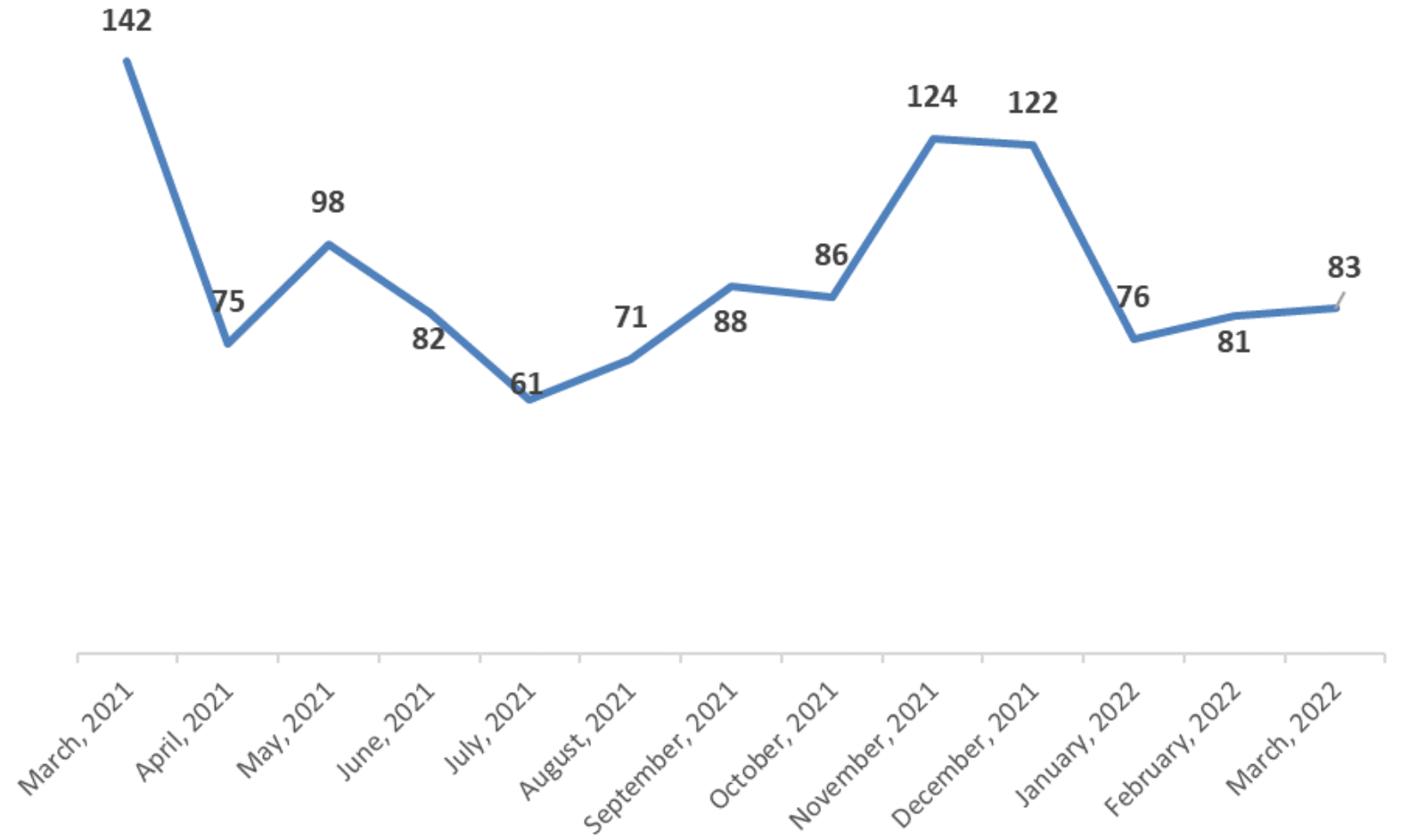

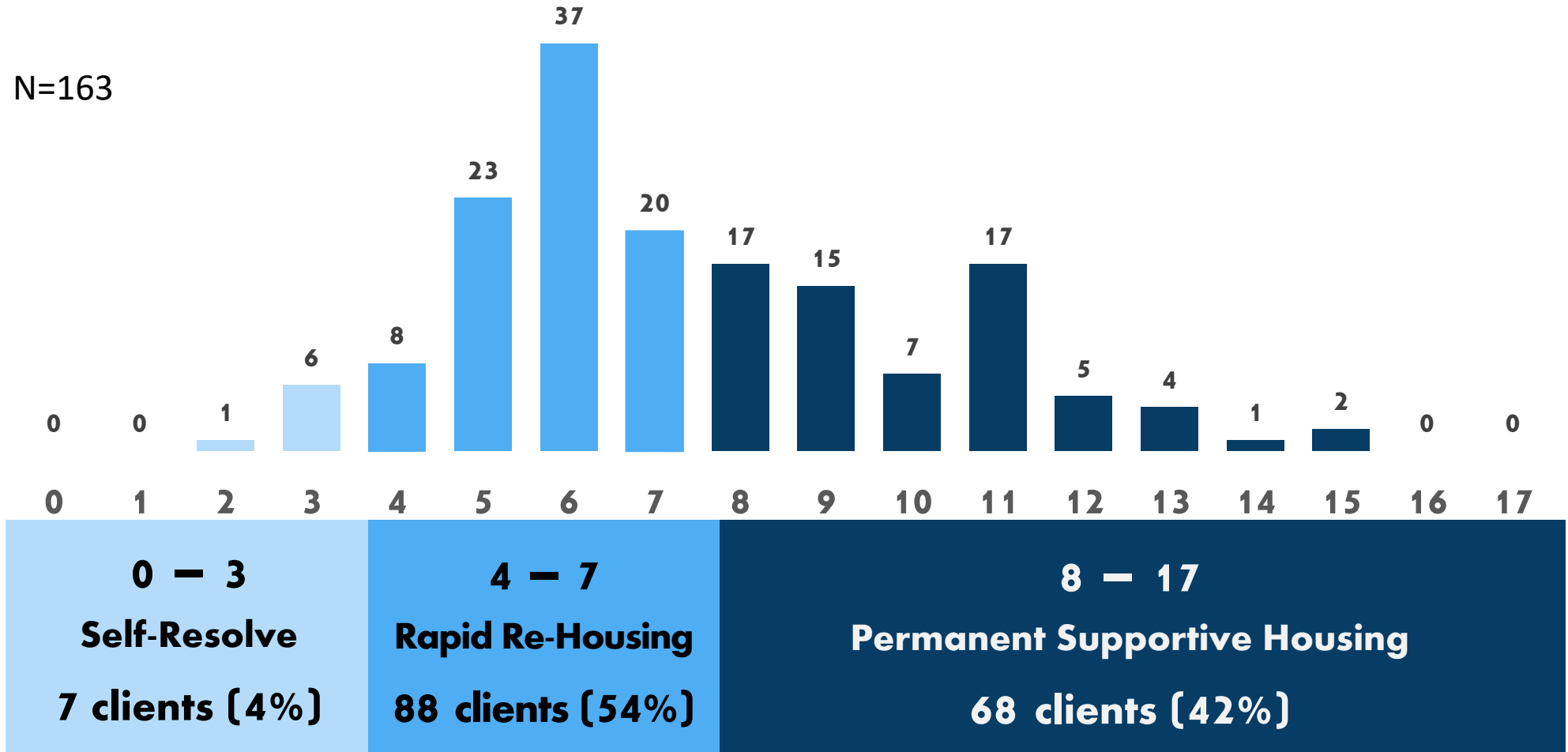

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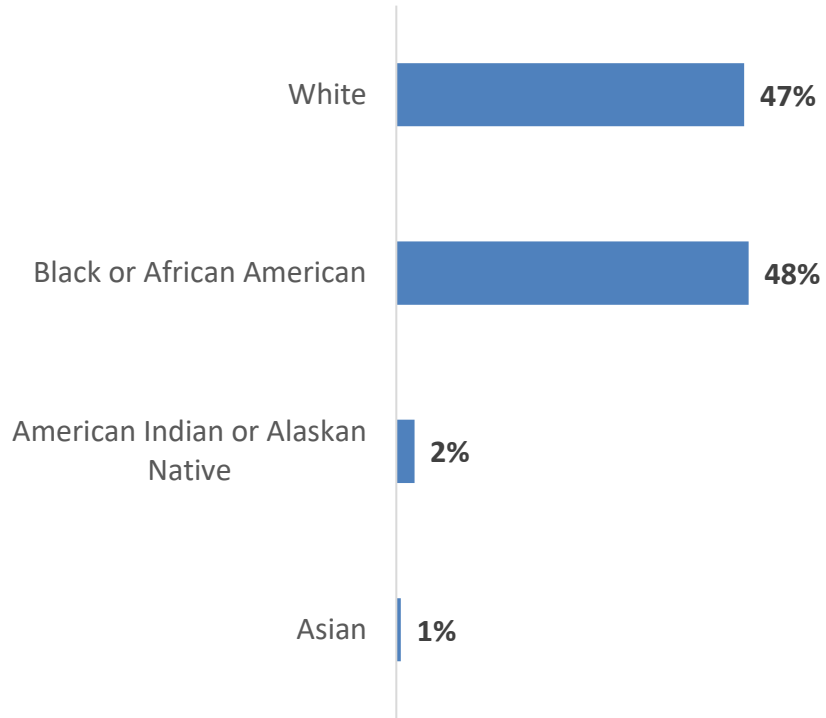

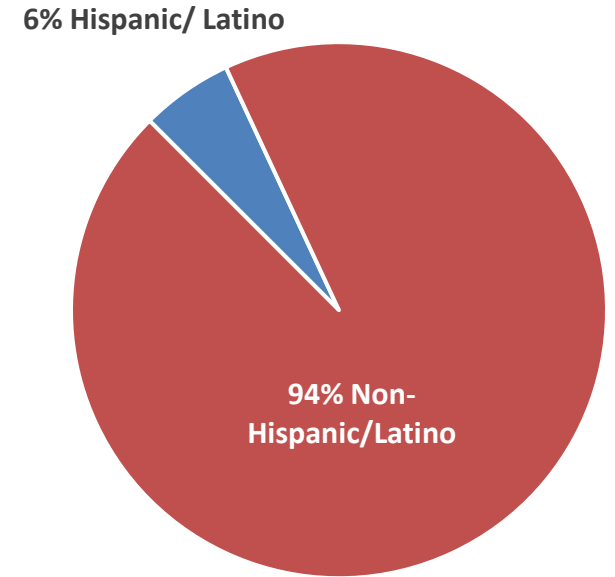

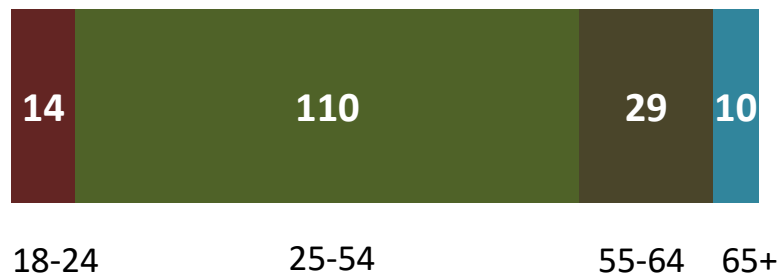

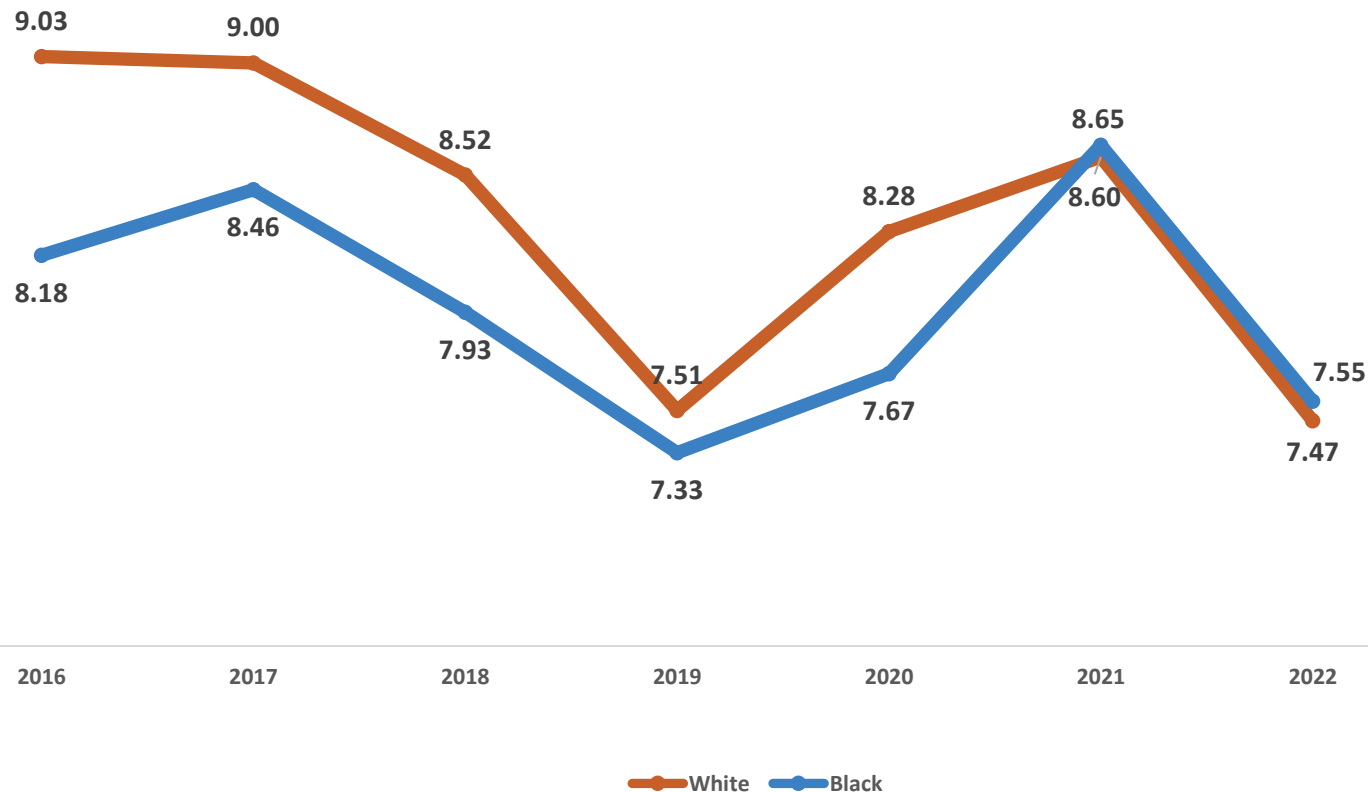

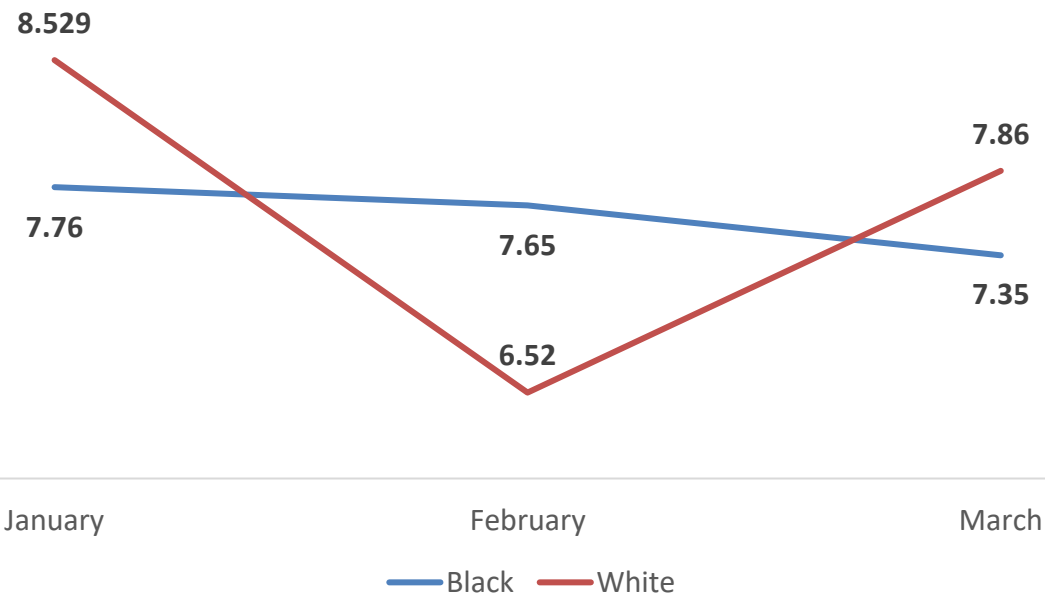
# Individual VI-SPDAT Scores: Racial Disparity Over Time



Average yearly scores, by race. There is a clear bias towards higher scores for white persons, with an average difference of .5 points. Since this assessment contributes to the prioritization of limited housing resources, lower scores for Black persons may indicate a systemic access issue.

# Individual VI-SPDAT Scores: Racial Disparity January to March

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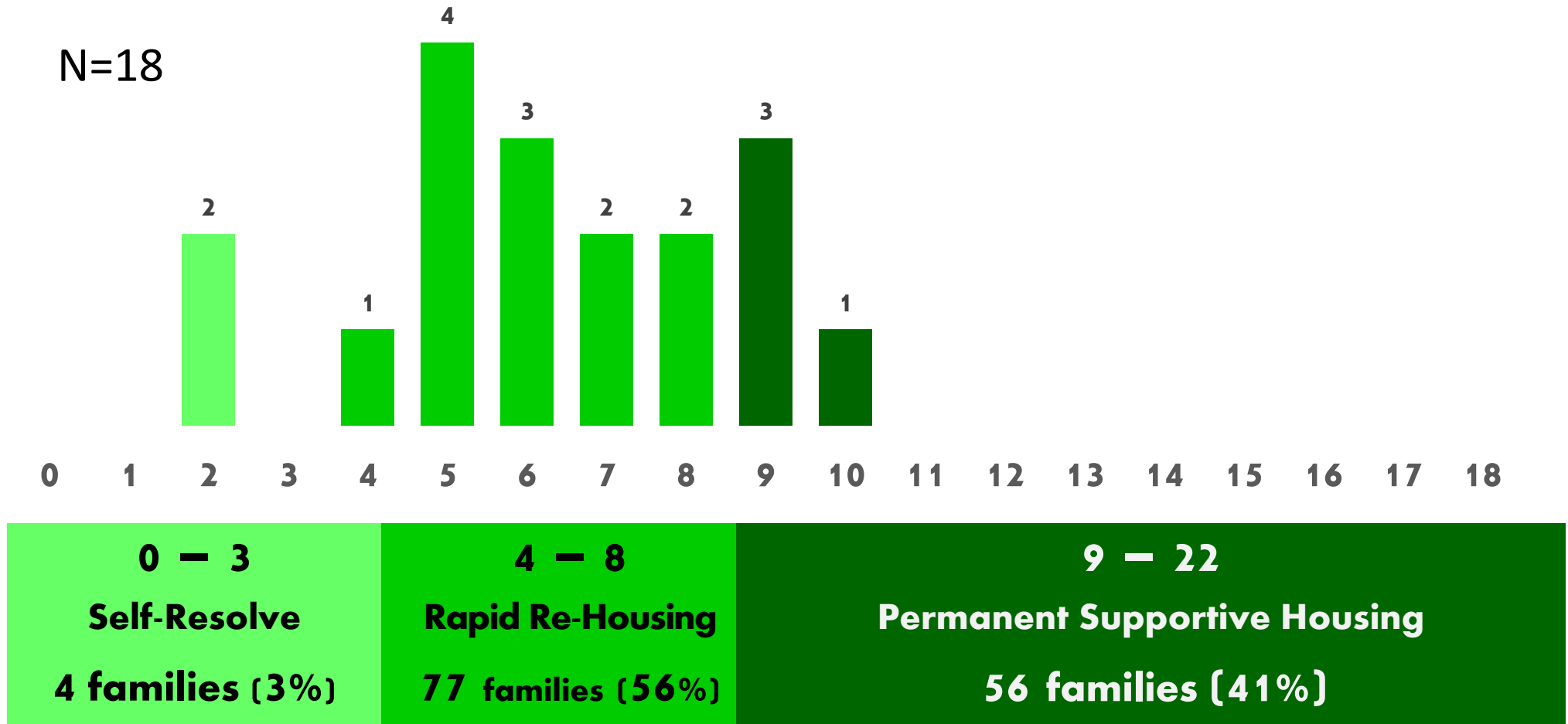


The racial disparity may not be observed each month but has been consistent over longer periods of time.

This past 3 months the disparity was .06 points higher for persons identifying as white.

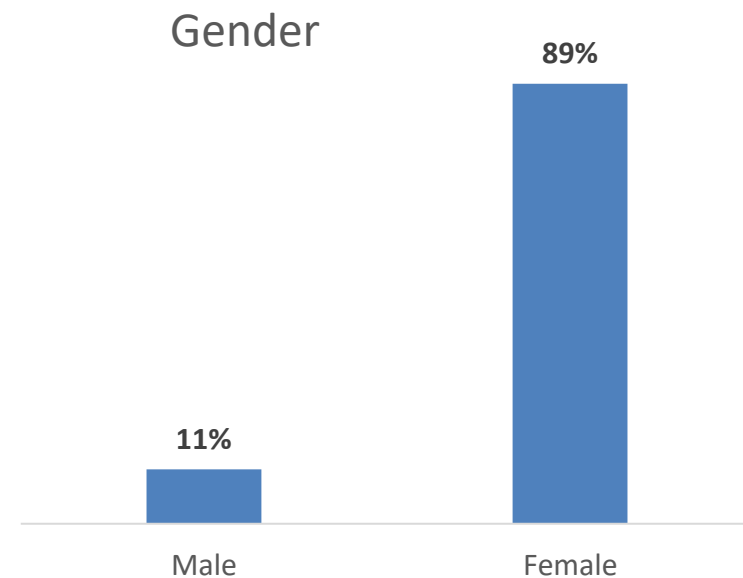
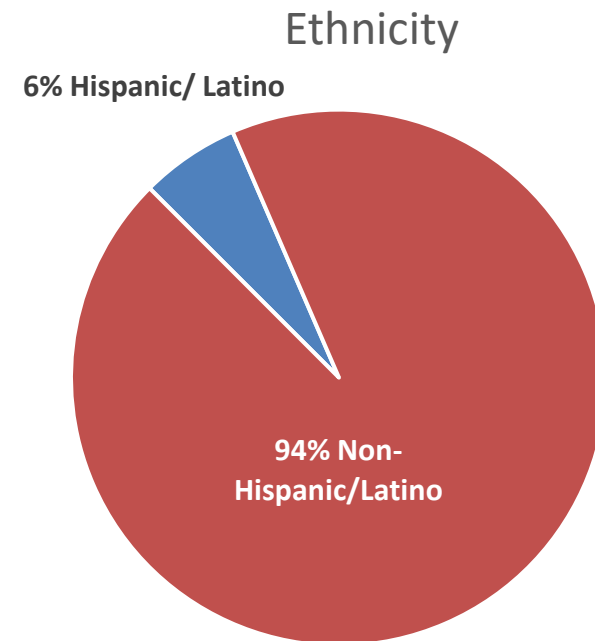
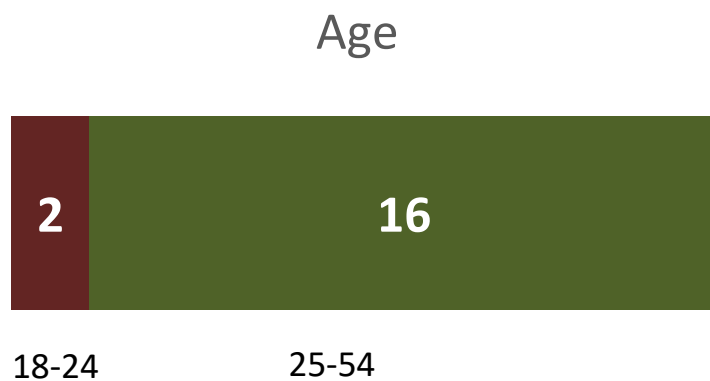
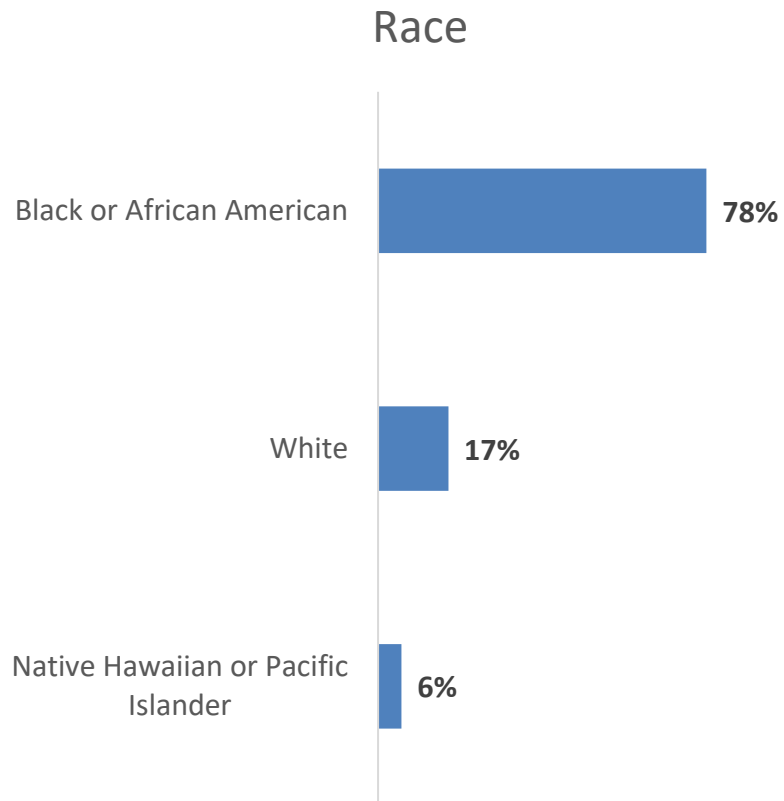

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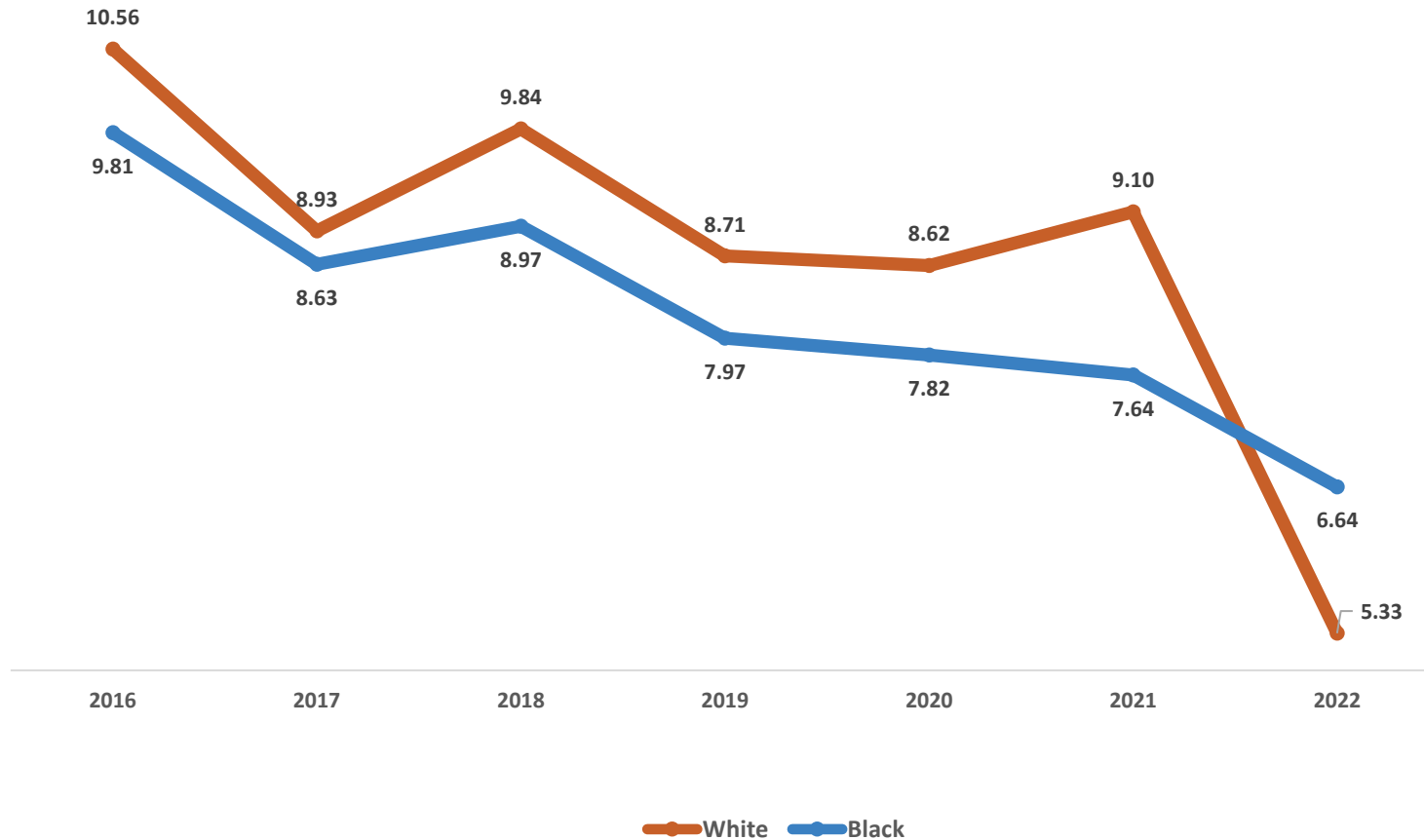
# VI-SPDAT Head of Household Demographics January to March 2021

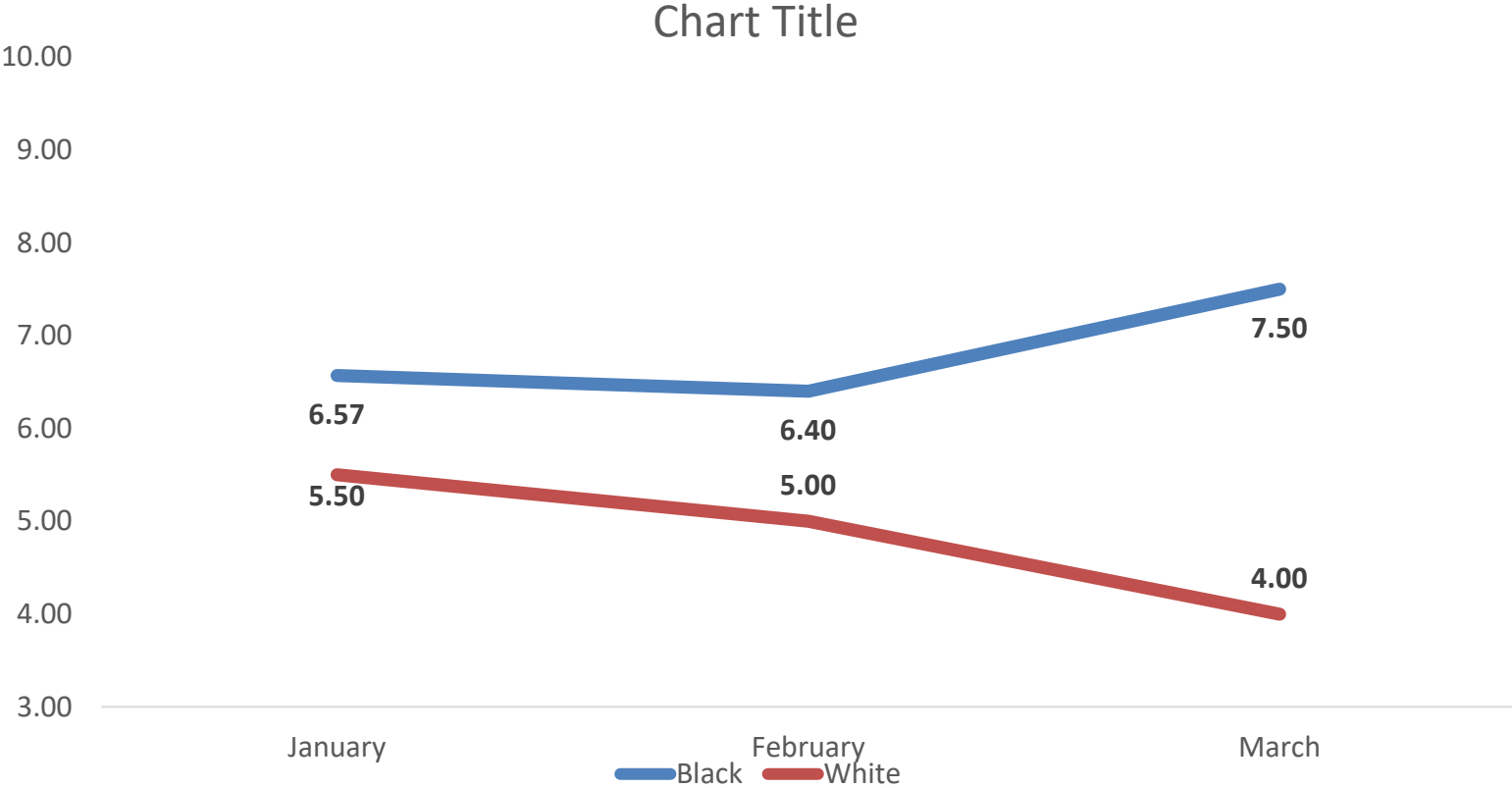


# Family VI-F-SPDAT Scores: Racial Disparity Over Time

# System Performance Measures (SPMs)

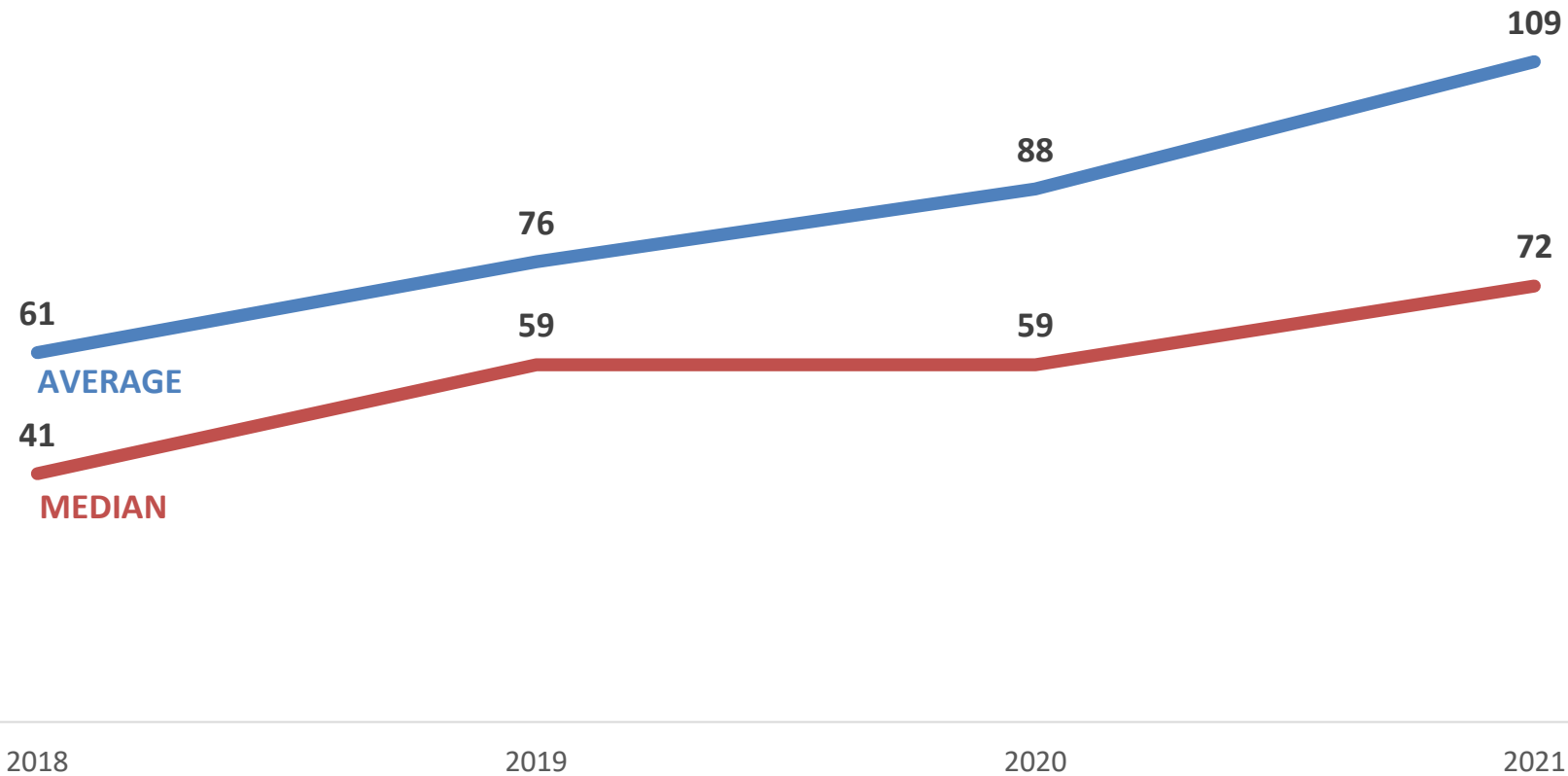
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System Performance Measures are a set of metrics to help communities understand how their homelessness response is performing as a coordinated system.

There are 7 total SPMs. We will review one or two in each quarterly meeting.

# Measure 1.1: Length of Time Persons Remain Homeless in ES & TH

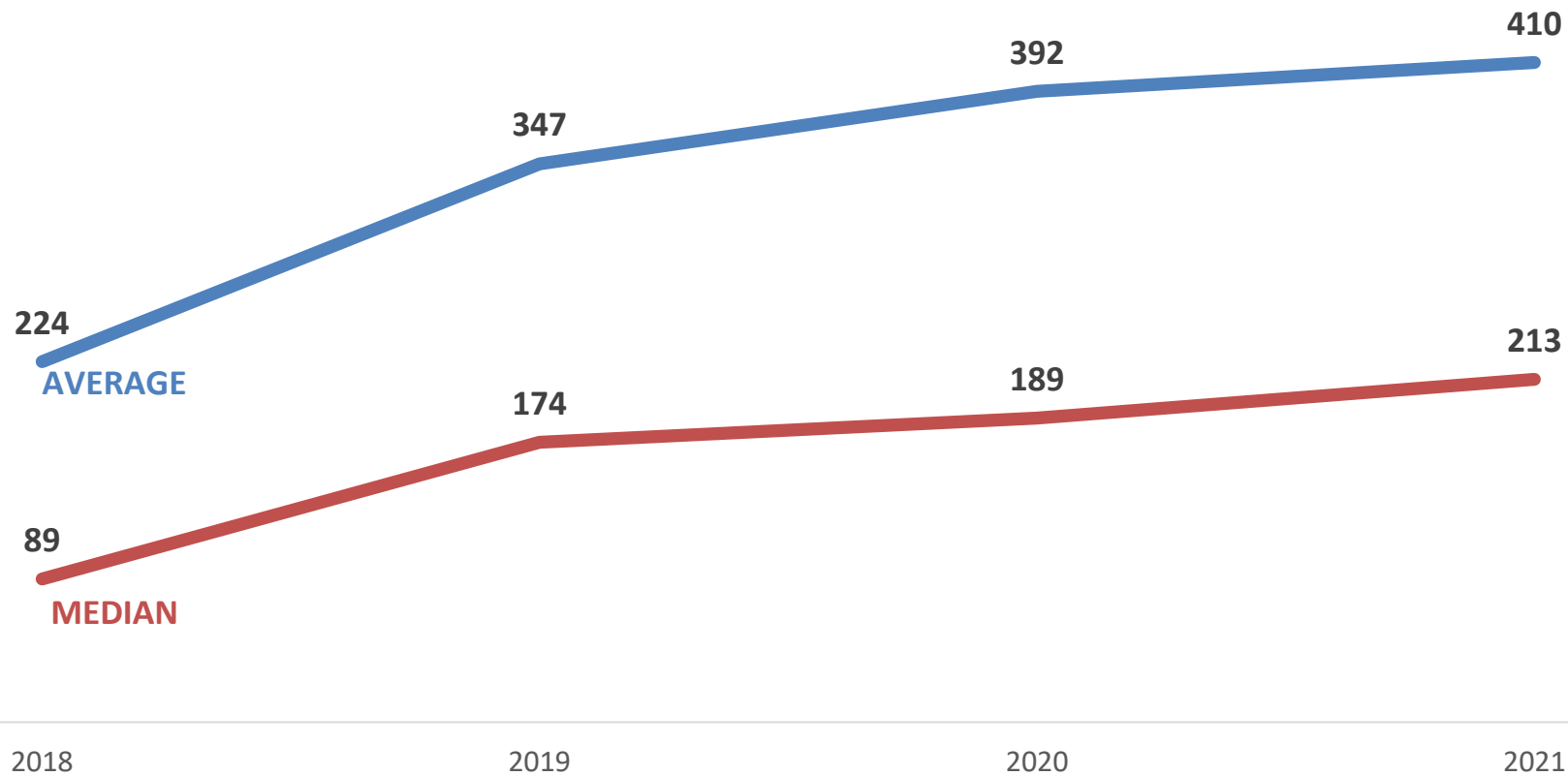
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This measure looks at time in shelter or transitional housing, starting with program entry

# Measure 1.1: Length of Time Persons Remain Homeless in ES & TH

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This measure looks at time in shelter or transitional housing, starting with the date the client reports becoming homeless

# Measure 2: Returns to Homelessness

This measure reports on clients who exited to a permanent housing destination in the date range two years prior to the report date range. Of those clients, the measure reports on how many of them returned to homelessness as indicated in the HMIS for up to two years after their initial exit.
