RE: Important 2023 Washtenaw County Pollution Prevention Program Update

Dear Owner/Operator:

As we shared last year, the Washtenaw County Pollution Prevention Program is on a “pause.” This pause is allowing our staff to thoroughly review and update the current regulation. It is also providing the opportunity to engage with community members, partners, and regulated businesses to determine how best to move our program forward.

Please note the following important updates for 2023:

Your facility does not need to submit status sheets or fees for 2023.

You are still responsible for fees for services in 2021 and prior. If your business owes prior fees, an invoice is included with this letter. In addition, we will not be performing routine inspections in 2023. We will continue to investigate complaints and emergency situations and follow up on issues that may need enforcement. We are also available for any questions you may have regarding your facility.

You and your staff are invited to feedback sessions on the Pollution Prevention Program.

We want to establish an updated regulation that protects public and environmental health in today’s world, while being conscious of the needs of our regulated community. We need your input to help make this a success, so we are hosting discussion sessions for you to share your thoughts, concerns, and suggestions. **Please use the QR code below or visit surveymonkey.com/r/p2meet to register for a feedback session.** Registration is not required, but helps us in planning.
