3. Who/what types of facilities should be exempt from the program?
4. What should be the inspection frequency for your facility? (currently annually, with potential of reduced frequency of every 2 or 4 years depending on volume)
 - a. Do others inspect your facility's chemical handling and storage procedures?
 - b. Should there be a reduced frequency of inspections? If so, what should be the criteria?
5. Should secondary containment be required?
 - a. What about a grace period and then mandatory for various situations?
6. Do you have suggestions for improvement of the status sheets/reporting forms?
 - a. Are you already reporting that info in a way that could be readily uploaded to a different database?
7. Do you have suggestions for fees?
8. How do we learn about new businesses that should be in the program?
