About Delinquent Taxes

You have time to make tax payments.

You don't have to pay all at once; partial payments help a lot. We cannot waive any of the fees and interest added by State law, but partial payments can reduce future interest.

If you are unable to pay, you may qualify for a Hardship Extension from foreclosure or other resources.

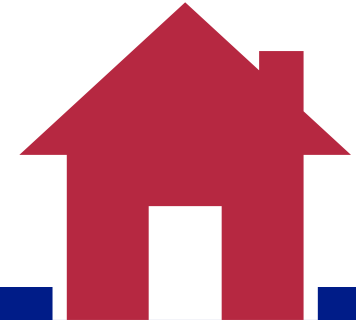

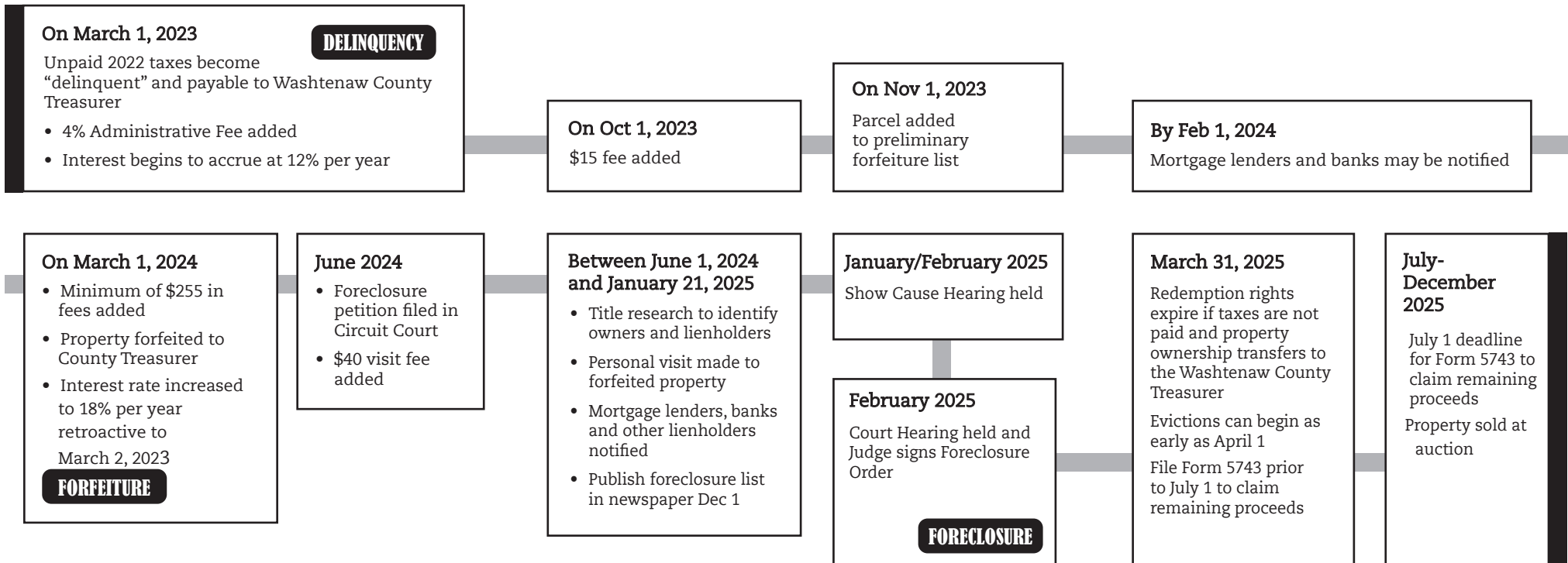
