

**Effective Date:** Upon Approval of the State Court Administrative Office

The purpose of this Local Administrative Order (LAO), in accordance with MCR 8.110 (D) (2) and MCR 8.112 (B), is to establish the holiday schedule observed by the 14A District Court upon approval by the State Court Administrative Office. It rescinds any and all previous Administrative Orders or Court policies that may address the same matter.

**IT IS ORDERED:**

To establish a holiday schedule that most closely aligns with the Court's funding unit and the Washtenaw County Trial Court (22<sup>nd</sup> Circuit Court), it is the policy of the 14A District Court that the following holidays shall be observed:

3. \*Should a holiday fall on Sunday, Monday shall be considered the holiday.
