The recall claims are completely false. Michigan election law requires that recall claims be clear; unfortunately it does not require them to be true.

As full-time Clerk with responsibility for elections, voter registration, accounting, and records management, I have spent countless hours serving our community. I am proud of what this administration has accomplished and the goals that we are working toward. Our finances are rock solid, our township water supply system has been upgraded, and our police and fire departments are well staffed and equipped. With your support, we will work hard to continue the progress in Pittsfield.

Response to recall claims:

1. I am not the highest paid township clerk in Washtenaw County. My salary is determined by an independent Compensation Commission and I voted to receive their recommendation for a modest 2.25% raise.
2. As a neighborhood resident, I attended a meeting hosted by the Washtenaw County Road Commission regarding safety concerns of area residents. I did not make the statement attributed to me by the recall sponsor.
3. The Road Commission never urged us to change the site plan and they told us that the approved plan is the safest.
