

We, the undersigned, registered and qualified voters of the Charter Township of Pittsfield, in the County of Washtenaw, and the State of Michigan, petition for the calling of an election to recall James Walter from the office of Township Supervisor for the following reasons:

1. On September 27, 2005, he voted to increase his own salary, making him the highest paid township supervisor in Washtenaw County.
2. On September 29, 2005, he falsely stated in a letter that there was an agreement with Wal-Mart prohibiting RV overnight parking at the proposed Wal-Mart/State Street Crossings site.
3. On June 10, 2005, he met with Washtenaw County Road Commission (WCRC) officials to discuss changing the main entrance of the proposed Wal-Mart store (at State Street and Michigan Avenue). Washtenaw County Road Commission officials urged the Township to consider a site plan change that would modify traffic impacts. He told the WCRC officials that this option was not acceptable to the Township. He made a site plan decision without first letting the Planning Commission vote on it.
