Township Supervisor, James Walter, failed in his official responsibilities by failing to ask the Pittsfield Township Department of Public Safety to investigate emergency response times relating to the proposed State Street Crossings/Wal-Mart development to ensure the health and safety of Township residents would be preserved.
3. Township Supervisor, James Walter, in a meeting with Washtenaw County Road Commission officials usurped the power of the Planning Commission by preventing the Planning Commission from discussing and voting on suggested changes to the proposed State Street Crossings/Wal-Mart development.
