

We, the undersigned, registered and qualified voters of the Charter Township of Pittsfield, in the County of Washtenaw, and the State of Michigan, petition for the calling of an election to recall James Walter from the office of Township Supervisor for the following reasons:

1. Failing to take any substantive action during his current term in office to ensure the safety and welfare of township residents regarding the State Street Crossings/Wal-Mart development, and undermining residents' efforts to mitigate the development's financial and safety impacts.
2. Failing to exercise fiscal responsibility during his current term in office by voting to increase his own salary despite the present financial situation of the township.
3. Making knowingly false statements which misled township residents, including a letter dated September 29, 2005, regarding an agreement prohibiting RV overnight parking at the proposed Wal-Mart development.
4. Usurping the authority of the Planning Commission by preventing the Planning Commission from discussing and voting on changes to the proposed State Street Crossings/Wal-Mart development that were suggested by the Washtenaw County Road Commission on or about June 10, 2005.
