

We, the undersigned registered and qualified voters of the Township of Lyndon, in the County of Washtenaw, and the State of Michigan, petition for the calling of an election to recall Maryann Noah from the office of Township Supervisor for the following reasons:

1. During the years 2004 through 2006 she violated township zoning ordinance 5.2 which permits "single family dwellings" only, by renting a portion of her home to a second, unrelated family.
2. She acted alone without township board discussion and authorization to settle an insurance claim for vandalism to town hall windows. (Claim # 124693, check # 20407, amount \$3932.00 processed on May 1st, 2006.
3. At February 13<sup>th</sup>, 2007 Board meeting, she stated that Lyndon Township would "roll out the red carpet" to get cell phone towers that are desperately needed. She then stated she had refused a cell phone company's offer to put up a tower on her 80 acres.
4. On February 13<sup>th</sup>, 2007 she admitted to the public that there was no environmental study done that would necessitate forcing installation of Multi-Lake Sewer around Island Lake.
