

We, the undersigned, registered voters of Salem Township, Washtenaw County, State of Michigan, petition for an election to recall Robert Heyl from the office of Township Supervisor for the following reasons:

1. Failure to follow the Township Bid Policy in seeking a new attorney firm. Robert Heyl admitted the township attorney was replaced for "political reasons."
2. The former dismissed attorney was instrumental in a \$2.1 million landfill litigation victory for the township. As a result nearly one million dollars is received annually. There was \$50 million at risk in the recent Arbitration, or \$25,000 per home. Robert Heyl failed to inform Salem public for 12 months about this risk.
3. Robert Heyl has selectively restricted the firefighters' speech at township meetings. He has participated in a public attack on the Fire Administration Board, Fire Chief and firefighters jeopardizing public safety.
4. Robert Heyl authorized the new township attorney to begin work to evict the Post Office from township property.
5. Robert Heyl failed to disclose during the election that he was sued, individually, by Pennzoil for Trademark Infringement, Counterfeiting, Unfair Business Practices, and Unjust Enrichment, therefore damaging the integrity of the democratic process.
