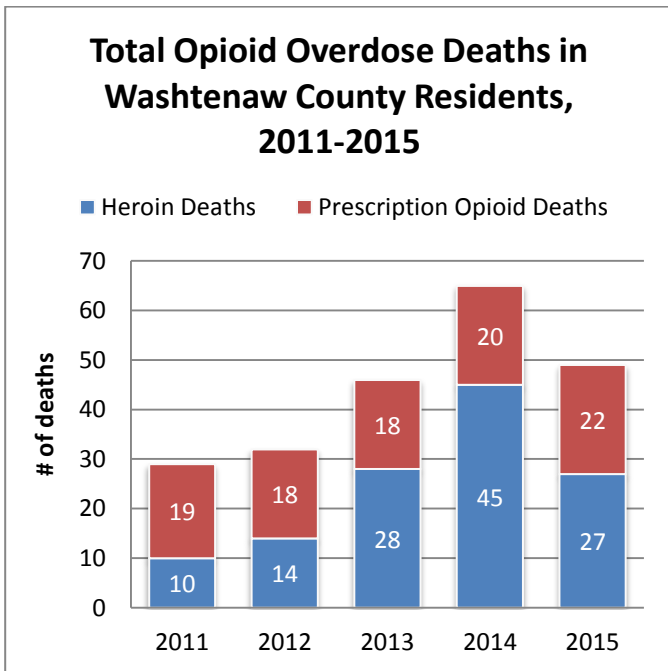
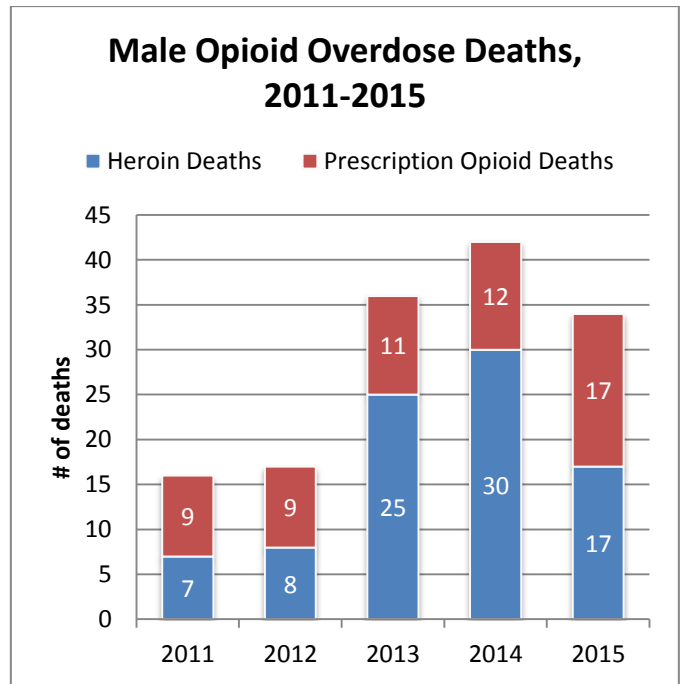
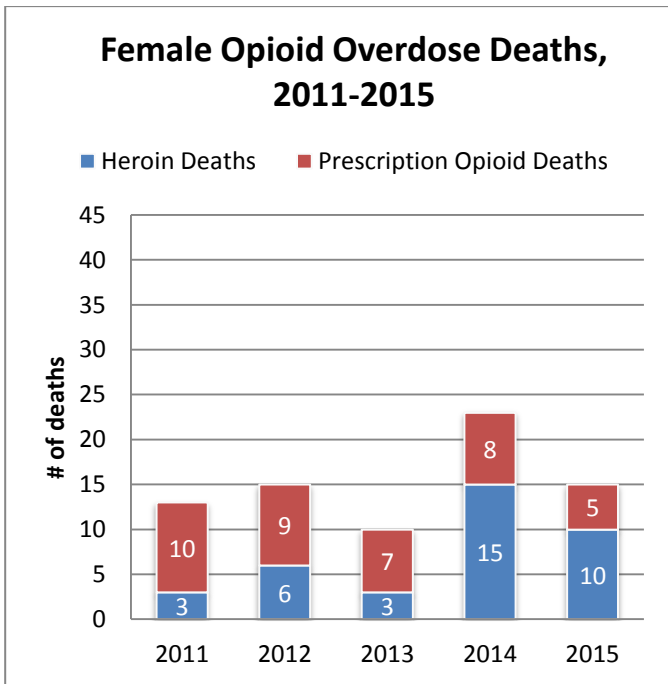


Prescription Opioid and Heroin Overdose Deaths Washtenaw County Residents, 2011-2015

2011

- Age range of heroin deaths 16-57 years (mean 43)
- Age range of prescription opioid deaths 24-63 years (mean 47)
- Fentanyl was found in one overdose death (3%)

2012

- Age range of heroin deaths 18-56 years (mean 39)
- Age range of prescription opioid deaths 20-60 years (mean 44)
- Fentanyl was not found in any overdose deaths

2013

- Age range of heroin deaths 18-59 years (mean 35)
- Age range of prescription opioid deaths 21-62 years (mean 42)
- Fentanyl was found in 4 overdoses deaths (9%)

2014

- Age range of heroin deaths 18-70 years (mean 39)
- Age range of prescription opioid deaths 19-71 years (mean 49)
- Fentanyl was found in 5 overdose deaths (7%)

2015

- Age range of heroin deaths 19-65 years (mean 40)
- Age range of prescription opioid deaths 1-57 years (mean 38)
- Fentanyl was found in 21 overdose deaths (43%)
